Free text (voluntary)	<p>Slovenia has implemented Directive 2011/24/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council on the application of patients' rights in cross-border healthcare IN YEAR 2013. In view of future participation in European reference networks the Slovenian Ministry of health named in autumn 2014 an expert working group to prepare national criteria to nominate Slovenian reference centers. It must be stressed though that some Slovenian centers of specialized care are already informally networking with related institutions in Europe and elsewhere.</p> <p>However, Rules on the conditions and procedure for obtaining the title of clinic, clinical institute or clinical department Institute have been in place in Slovenia for 20 years now and contain some similar requirements for tertiary health care providers as are those, described in the new Commission Delegated Decision of 10 March 2014 setting out criteria and conditions that European Reference Networks and healthcare providers wishing to join a European Reference Network must fulfill.</p>
