## **Scope and Context**







#### Networks of healthcare providers aiming at

Improving quality and safety and access to highly specialised healthcare

✓ Patients affected by rare or low prevalence and complex diseases

✓ multidisciplinary approach (different specialities/areas of knowledge) ✓ Added value at EU level

- ✓ Need of cooperation:
  - > Scarcity knowledge
  - Need education
  - Complexity / high cost
  - ➤ Effectiveness in the use of resources

## **Key features of the Networks**

- ✓ Patient centered and clinically lead
- ✓ 10 Members in at least 8 Countries
- ✓ Strong independent (3rd party) assessment
- ✓ Fulfillment of Network and Members criteria
- ✓ Endorsement and approval by National Authorities (grouping and strategic value)





#### **Members of the Networks**





## Healthcare providers:

Principal constituents of the ERN

- ✓ Cooperation amongst themselves in a field of expertise
- ✓ **Accordance with legislation** of their Member States
- ✓ Fulfillment of the criteria
- ✓ Responsibilities and tasks defined in the governance bodies of the ERN
- ✓ Hub (interconnector) between national healthcare providers and the ERN

## Networks criteria and capacities




- ✓ knowledge and expertise to diagnose, follow up and manage patients
- ✓ Evidence of good outcomes
- ✓ multi-disciplinary approach
- ✓ capacity to produce good practice guidelines and to implement outcome measures and quality control
- ✓ Research, teaching and training
- ✓ collaborate with other centers of expertise and networks

- ✓ More than 50 interested groups or pilot networks identified
- ✓ **Dynamic interaction** of stakeholders with MS and Commission
- ✓ Preparatory work of Network proposals ongoing
- ✓ Interaction among professionals of the same thematic diseases groups
- ✓ Active implication of **EU patients and professional/scientific societies**
- ✓ Strong support of the Commission advisory groups (in particular the RD expert group)
- ✓ Close cooperation between Board of MS and Commission



## Challenges





- Attract and approve the right ERNs
- > Efective Network model & useful platforms and tools
- Commitment of Member States and sustainability
- Avoid fragmentation and overlaping
- Develop & use standardised tools (clinical guidelines, registries, patient pathways, interoperable IT systems)

To involve healthcare professionals, health authorities, managers and patients in a **common project** of ERNs.



### **Network aplication**





#### Value and content

What: epidemiology, thematic group of diseases, type of services

Why: demonstration of added value and technical reasons

**Who:** type of players (heterogeneity, consortiums, subareas of spesialisation, etc)

How: Criteria to be fulfilled a) as Network b) as member

Assessment of Networks proposals will focus on how well the proposal is envisaged and defined (as Networks are "in general" not set up so far)





#### **Network proposals: Preparatory and strategic activities**

- ✓ Strengthening the network value and capacities:
  - Multidisciplinarity
  - Avoid fragmentation: Grouping of diseases
  - ☐ Identify mature and clear EU added value type of diseases
  - ☐ Discuss and *Identify other players*, partners and members
- ✓ Liaison with MS authorities (contact with ERN board representative at national level and discuss !!)







### **Network proposals: Preparatory and strategic activities**

- ✓ Agree on the specific criteria for each area of expertise
- ✓ Define the services of the Network
- ✓ Self-assessment exercise (Network and members)
- ✓ Define **Pathways** models, referral criteria, clinical decision tools
- ✓ **Plan an Information** system




