Rapporteur has been selected. First version of the draft opinion has been discussed. New version will be prepared for the next meeting.

2.3. Preliminary Opinions open for comments

• Preliminary 'Scientific advice on the safety of nanomaterials in cosmetics' has been adopted by the SCCS by written procedure on 5 October and published for commenting period until 2 November. In total, 10 comments were received from the different stakeholders. The replies to comments have been prepared and discussed.
