GAVI?

- Public-private partnership
- Created in 2000
- Helps ensure more children can access vaccines
- Shapes vaccine markets, and accelerates the uptake and use of underused and new vaccines in more than 70 of the world's poorest countries.
- Since 2000, GAVI has supported the immunization of 440 million children and helped prevent 6 million deaths.

Power of Vaccines

- One of the most cost-effective health intervention
- Saves 2-3 million lives/year
- 22,6 million children remain unimmunised with basic vaccines
- 1/5 of under-5 deaths linked to vaccine preventable causes
