7. REQUEST FOR CLARIFICATION ON OPINION SCCS/1348/10 IN LIGHT OF THE DANISH CLAUSE OF SAFEGUARD BANNING THE USE OF PARABENS IN COSMETIC PRODUCTS INTENDED FOR CHILDREN UNDER THREE

Denmark has banned propyl and butyl parabens as well as their isoforms and salts in cosmetic products for children up to three years of age. This ban entered into force on 15 March 2011 and has lead to a notification to the European commission under article 12 of the Cosmetics Directive 76/768/EEC. The Commission has requested the SCCS to clarify whether the safety concerns raised in the justification for the imposed ban have been considered in the recent assessment of parabens adopted on 22 March 2011.

A first draft for a response to this request was discussed. A further discussion will take place in the next meeting of 31 May.

The next meeting will take place on 31 May 2011. Further meeting dates have been set for 19 July and 6 September.
