

Study on the EU Health Policy Platform (HPP)

The Health Policy Platform (HPP) was set up in 2016 and has continued to growing users and content since then. To appraise the Platform and identify areas of improvement, the European Commission's Directorate General of Health and Food Safety (DG SANTE) has commissioned Tetra Tech International Development and partners to conduct a **“Study assessing the EU Health Policy Platform”**. The independent assessment will focus on the last two years of the HPP activities.

The **main objective** of the study is to provide DG SANTE with a robust evidence about the use and functioning of the Health Policy Platform including its relevance, effectiveness, efficiency, coherence with Commission policies and health actions, added-value and impact.

Scope of the study

The study will cover the **main activities of the HPP**, including:

- The various **networks** hosted by the Platform;
- The **Live Webinars** organised through the Platform; and
- The previous editions of the **EU Health Award**.
