Scientific Committee on Consumer Safety (SCCS) Meeting of the Working Group on Cosmetic Ingredients in Cosmetic Products

19-20 November 2024, Luxembourg

Minutes

1. Welcome and apologies, approval of the agenda and declaration of interest

The Chair welcomed the participants. This was a hybrid meeting. One apology for being absent was received for both days, one for one day and a half, and one for half a day. DG GROW was participating.

The Chair invited participants to declare any interest regarding matters on the agenda. None of the participants declared any new interest conflicting with the matters on the agenda. Any interest already reported in the annual declaration remains valid.

2. List of points discussed

2.1. Draft Opinions

The WG discussed preliminary opinions on:

- Salicylic acid children exposure
- Butylparaben children exposure
- Submission II for HC Red 18 (B124)
- Melaleuca Alternifolia (Tea Tree) Leaf Oil CMR exemption
- Prostaglandins
- Diethylamino Hydroxybenzoyl Hexyl Benzoate

Tasks were allocated among members and these preliminary texts will be further discussed in the next WG meeting.

HC Red 18 will be adopted by written procedure before the next WG meeting and published for comments.

A corrigendum is under preparation for the final addendum (SCCS/1668/24) to the opinion on Hexyl Salicylate (children exposure). It will be adopted by written procedure and replaced on the website.

Literature search: first results for Benzophenone 5 will be assessed before launching a new request for benzophenone 2. The SCCS decided to launch the literature search for Butylated Hydroxyanisole (BHA) in the meantime.

2.2. Final documents

The WG discussed:

• Scientific Advice on Methylsalicylate - children exposure

Final text will be finalised by the rapporteur before adoption by written procedure.
