Steering Group and the role of the EGHI

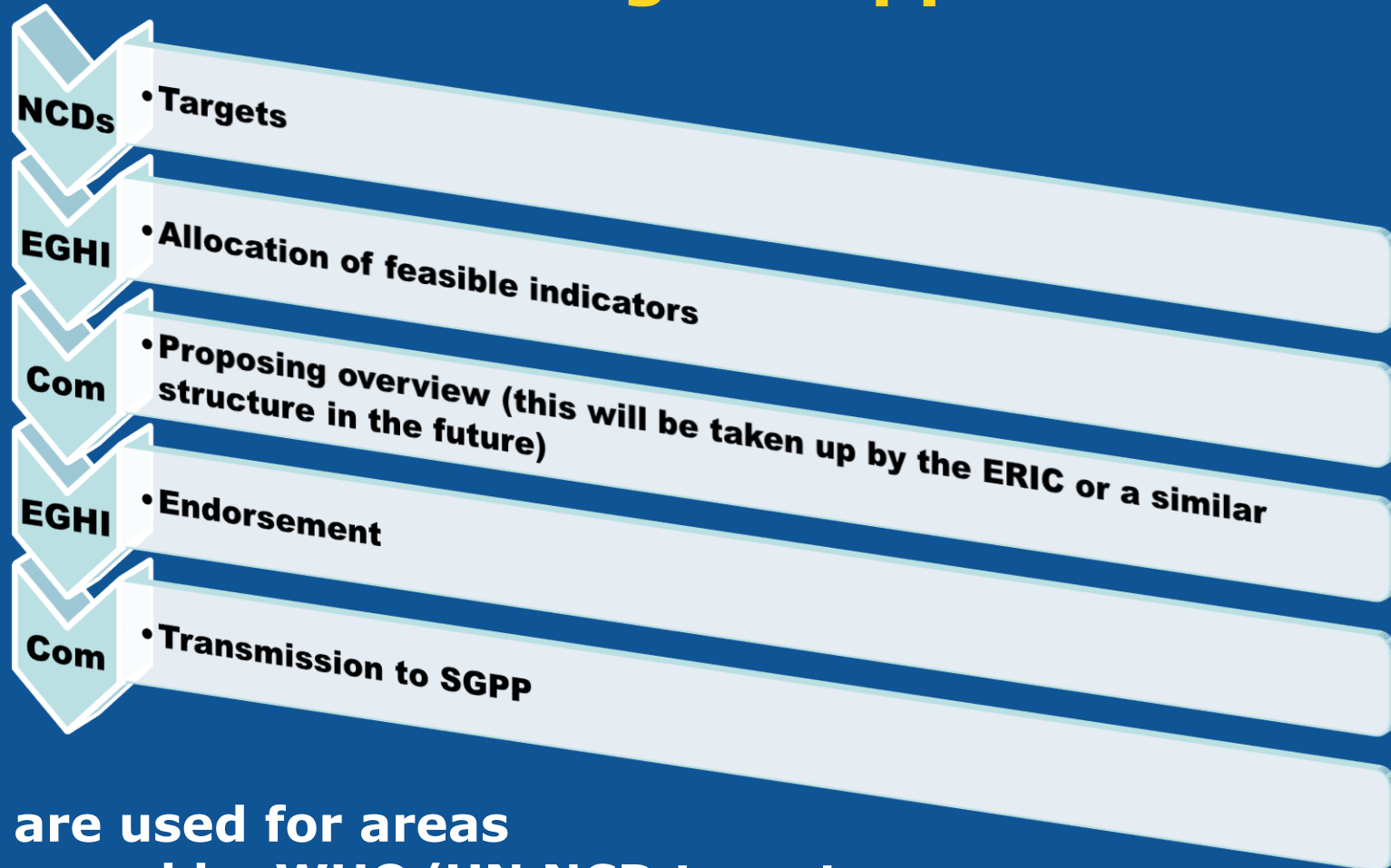
- **The EGHI provides relevant health data to the SGPP to support decision-making in the context of the SGPP's prioritized activities**

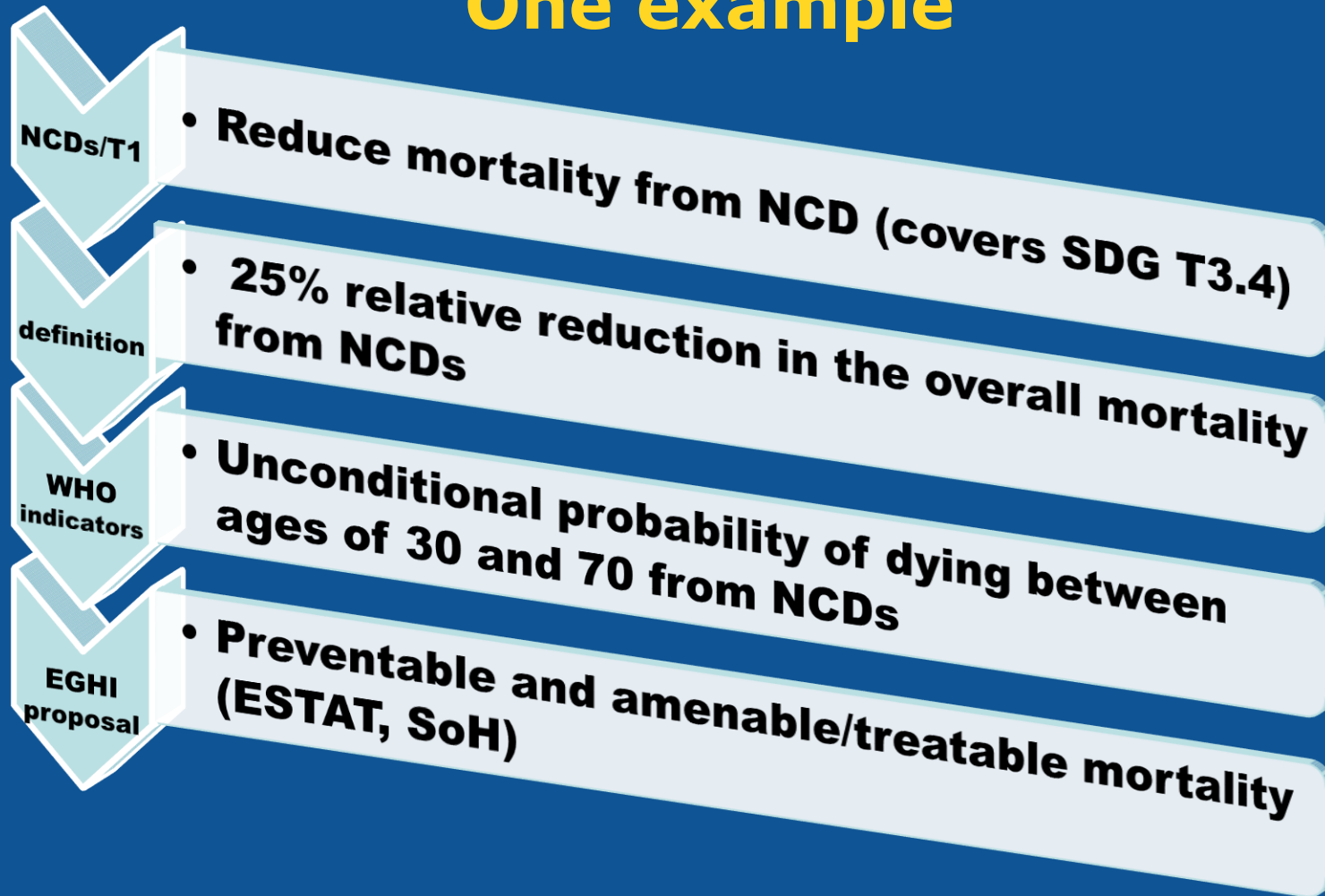

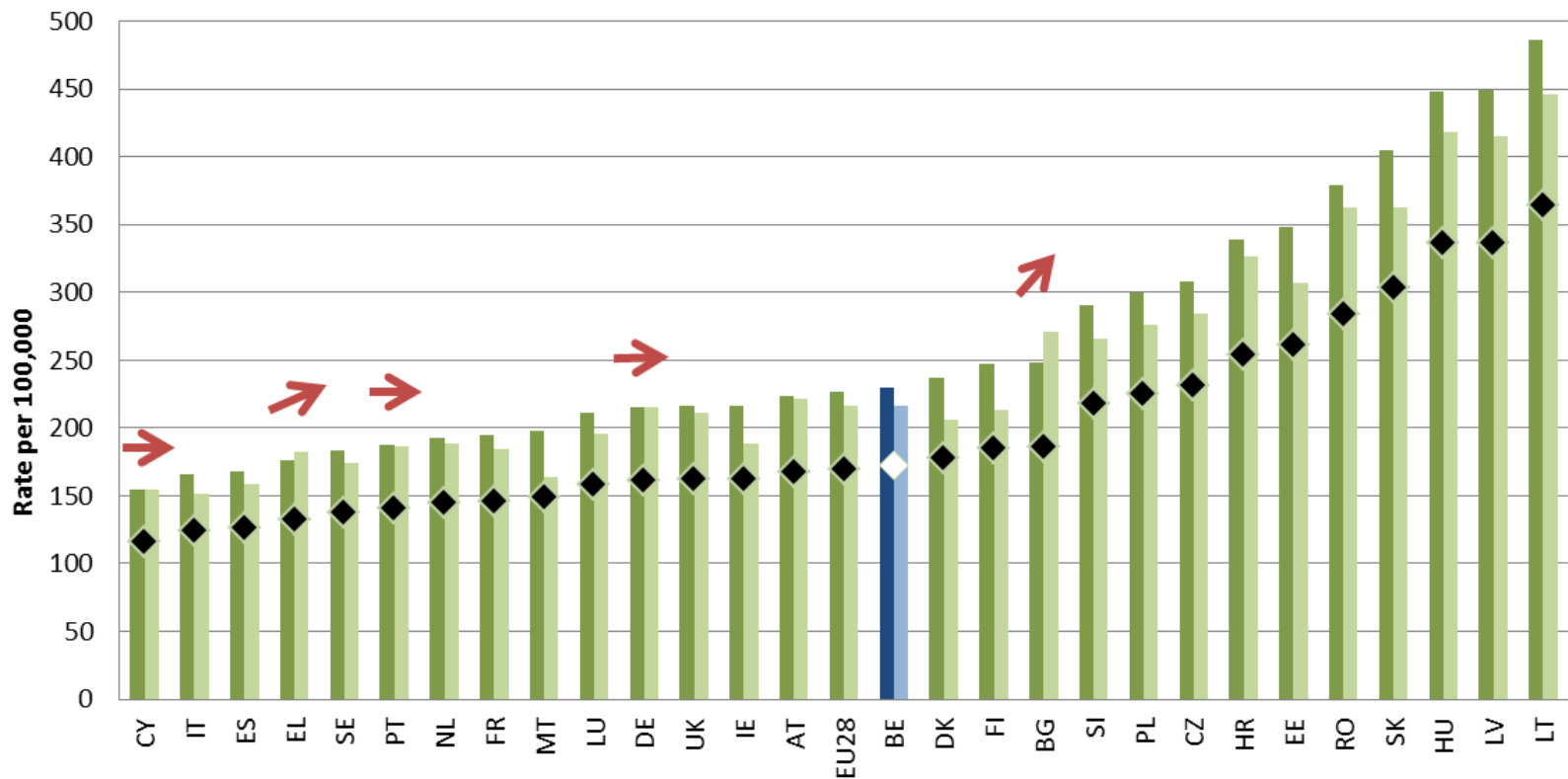

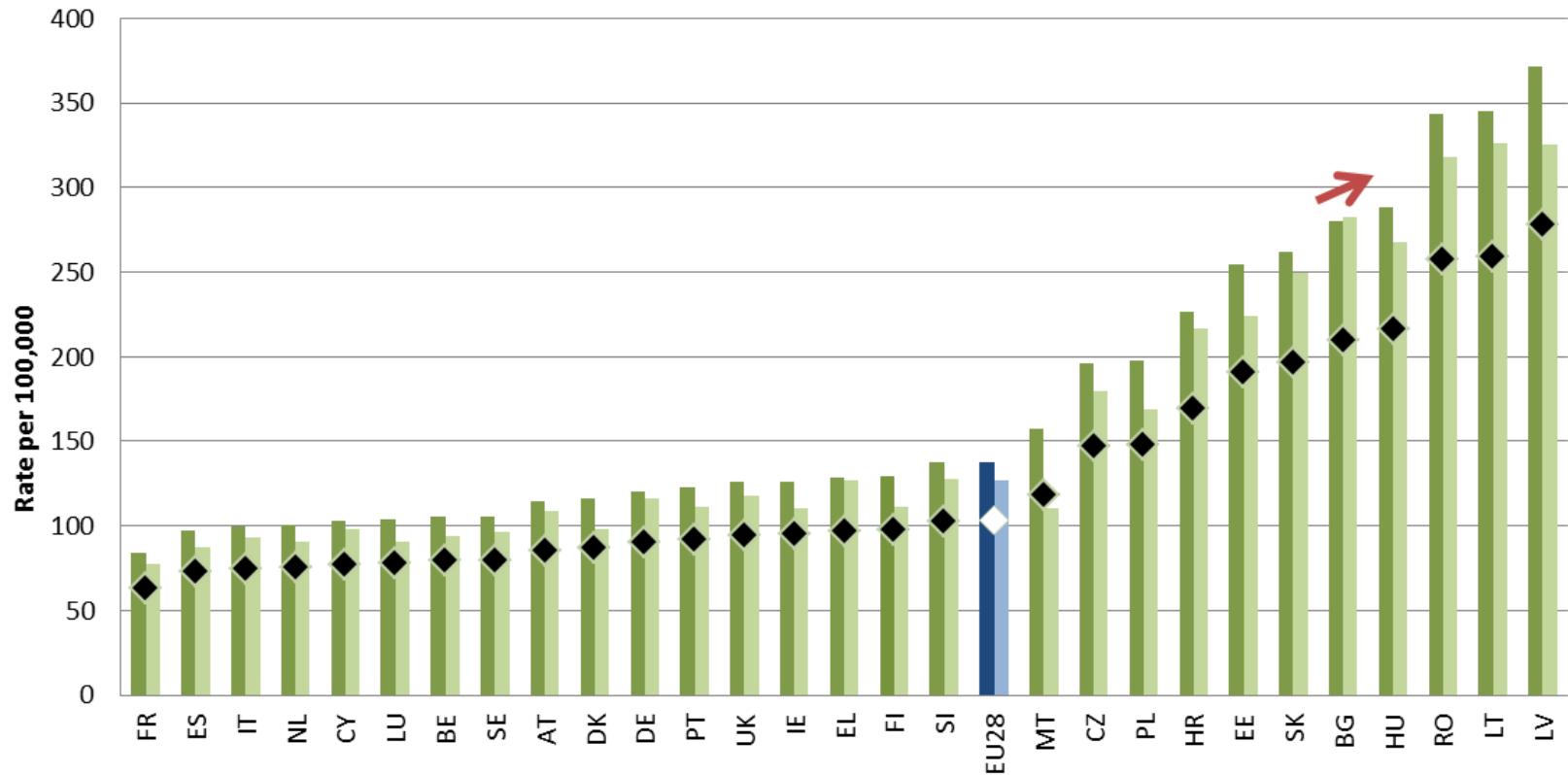
Preventable mortality in the EU 2011 vs 2015 and 2025 Target

Amenable (treatable) mortality in the EU 2011 vs 2015 and 2025 Target



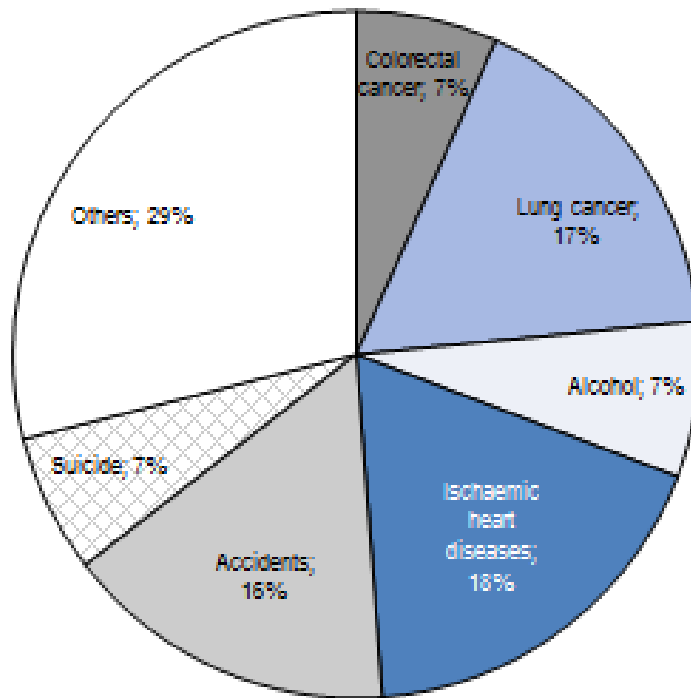

Leading causes of preventable and amenable mortality in the European Union, 2015

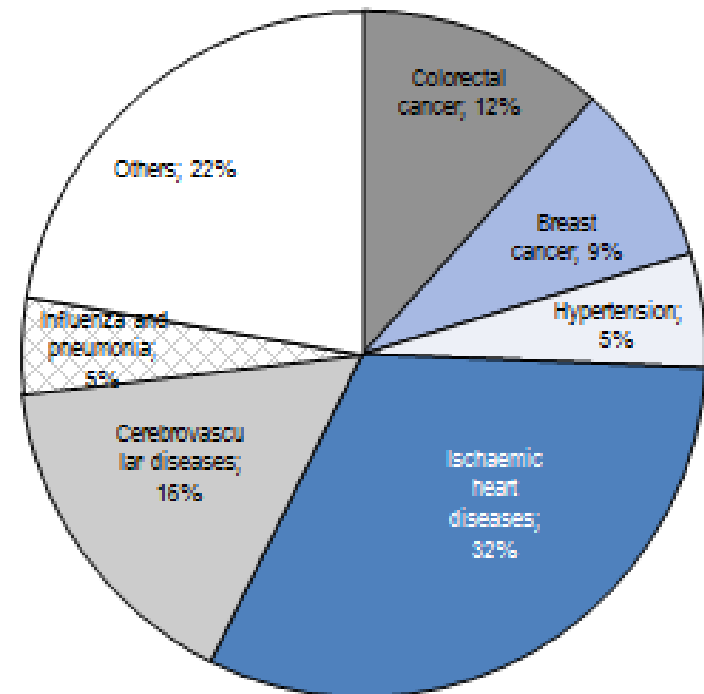
Preventable mortality
