# The pilot



## Objective

Identify research results which have a potential to be implemented in the interested Member States with a high likelihood of having a positive impact on health – **e-health/m-health selected as area of interest.**

## Process

Screen results of the EU funded research projects and assessed against the criteria set



Those projects which have produced results and comply with the criteria will be identified and submitted to the SGPP

# Best Practice criteria



## 1: Exclusion

- Relevance
- Intervention characteristics
- Evidence and theory based
- Ethical aspects

## 2: Core

- Effectiveness and Efficiency of the intervention
- Equity

## 3: Qualifier

- Transferability
- Sustainability
- Participation
- Intersectoral collaboration

# The Process



## Action

Select keywords

Run the query on FP7 and Horizon 2020

Screen manually the projects fitting the area

Apply the best practice criteria

Present the results that are suitable for MS adoption

## Outcome

m-health, e-health, telecare, telemedicine, telehealth, health tech, digital health, connected health, health apps

152 projects found  
€ +- 253 M

## Some initial findings

Out of the **152** projects identified through key words

- **63** were not really about e-health/m-health
- The **89** remaining are of very diverse nature
  - (self) management (23)
  - Telemedicine
  - Digital platforms (Linking GP/Hospital/pharmacy)
  - Smart ambulance
  - Health literacy
  - .....

## Lessons learned

- Very time consuming
- Possibility to miss some results (correct keywords)
- Issue of classification of projects

=> Need to adapt the strategy

## Way forward

- Develop IT tools (e.g. Artificial Intelligence) to improve the first screening
- Refine the focus – identify “sub areas” of specific interest for MS
- Can we learn from identification processes in Member States?
