European Community Health Indicators (ECHI)

The purpose of the ECHI

- •Solid information on the health status of the EU citizens
- •Base for policy monitoring and setting of policy
- •Fourteen years of cooperation between the Commission and Member States
- Main results; shortlist of 88 indicators





European Community Health Indicators (ECHI)

- Linkage to policy areas
- Useful for setting and monitoring of policy
- The added value
 - Well defined
 - Allow for comparison
 - Harmonization of data collected
 - Allow for reduction of the response burden of MS



State of play

- Feedback was sought from the SLWP
