




Temporary networks in the EU Health Policy Platform

What is a joint statement?



Stakeholders are speaking together with one voice on priority health policy issues.

Thematic Networks may input to preparation on agreed Commission priorities or implementation of Commission ongoing initiatives.



Healthcare in Cross-Border Regions:

The context

Border areas are home to 40% of the European population.

This population has to deal with:

An hampered socio-economic development because of their peripheral location

Hindrance of free movement of labour and services that affect healthcare systems

HEALTH INEQUALITIES

Citizens are limited in their choice of and accessibility to healthcare and there is less room for cooperation

More obstacles for enterprises, healthcare providers and institutions, training services for the workforce, educational institutions and regional governments.


