Chapter 9 Transportation: Transportation, 9.1		Comment: The added guidelines of chapter 9 "Transportation" are stipulated in detail and will ensue comprehensive investments into transport control activities. In practice transportation duration can range between few hours to many weeks. In order not to impose the unreasonable, rigid specification to transport at storage conditions for short duration transports, transport specifications should be defined by the manufacturer or distributor based on stability data. E.g. if a medicinal product fulfills the release specifications under accelerated conditions (40°C, 6 months), it should be allowed to be transported for a total of 36 hours transportation time at temp. <40°C. Proposed change (if any): 9.1 The transport conditions for medicinal products during transportation should be defined on the basis of their stability data.
