6-7 June 2023, Helsinki - ECHA (hybrid)

Minutes

1. WELCOME AND APOLOGIES (CHAIR: PROF. Q. CHAUDHRY)

The Chair welcomed all participants, including the SCHEER representative and DG GROW. The agenda was adopted. One apology was received for both days.

The SCCS adopted two new mandates:

- on fragrance acetylated vetiver oil (acute inhalation submission IV)
- on aluminium for updated concentration use (update of submission IV)

SCCS informed DG GROW about their comments on a way forward with a potential mandate on salicylates.

WG on Methodologies

The 12th revision of the SCCS Notes of Guidance of the testing of the cosmetic ingredients and their safety evaluation was published mid-May: see SCCS Notes of guidance for the testing of cosmetic ingredients and their safety evaluation - 12th revision (europa.eu)

The SCCS participated the next day in a joint symposium ECHA/SCCS and discussed, in particular, the New Approach Methodology (NAMs) used in safety assessment of cosmetics.
