<b>3 February</b>	Adoption of the Europe's Beating Cancer Plan
<b>March 2021</b>	Launch of discussions in joint SGPP subgroup on cancer*
<b>Q2 2021</b>	Work Programme adoption and opening of calls WP2021
<b>May 2021</b>	Finalisation of implementation plan
<b>Q3 2021</b>	Decision on full implementation of missions
<b>Q3 2021</b>	Preparation of update WP 2022 for Missions WP part

# Mission on Cancer – preparatory phase



- **Prepare implementation plan:** definition of intervention logic, actions to be supported and timelines, synergies with other EU and national/regional initiatives, investment strategy;
- **Mission Board:** prolongation of mandate; regular board meetings, interaction with Member States and Mission Assembly;
- **Work plan 2021:** 5 million EUR for each mission to support **preparatory actions for accelerating implementation**; 5 million EUR for all missions to create a **Missions Core Network** to prepare implementation in each Member State, and foster cooperation between Member States, consisting of to-be-established Missions National Hubs.

## Procurement actions

Complementing the intervention area *Understanding*, procurement actions are foreseen in the following intervention areas: *Preventing the preventable*, *Optimising diagnosis and treatment*, and *Quality of life*. The fifth intervention area, *Equitable access*, will be systematically addressed in each of these procurement actions.

**Via the transnational network for mission implementation:** ‘Meet & Monitor Missions’ event and ‘Annual Missions innovation fair’.
