1. Welcome and apologies, approval of the agenda and declaration of interests

2. List of points discussed

A new mandate/dossier on nickel was presented by the Secretariat and will be added on the end of May agenda.

2.1. Subgroup for Groundwater Directive

The comments received on the preliminary Opinion on Groundwater will be discussed during the next WG meeting.

2.2. Subgroup for priority substances under the Water Framework Directive

The final opinions on clarithromycin and on bifenthrin were discussed. They are planned to be adopted by written procedure.

The preliminary opinions on diclofenac and on chlorpyrifos were discussed. They are planned to be adopted by written procedure.

The preliminary opinions on bisphenol A and triclosan will be discussed during the next WG meeting.

The preliminary Opinion on PFAS has been published for comment until 6 May 2022: <u>SCHEER - Opinions (europa.eu)</u>

The comments received on pyrethroids have been adopted in plenary meeting and final opinions will be published together, as the last updated dossier received has been taken into account (cf. bifenthrin above).

The comments received on preliminary Opinion on macrolide antibiotics azithromycin and clarithromycin have been discussed and SCHEER responses have been finalised. They are planned to be adopted by written procedure.
