- A 10 year-plan both at the EU level and at the French level in the fight against cancer.
- A strong political commitment from the President of the European Commission and the President of the French Republic


2 complementary strategies in favor of innovation


- Actions oriented towards innovation: genomics, innovation in cancer screening, implementation of digital mechanisms, data sharing...
- New legislative measures and new mechanisms envisioned by Europe's Beating Cancer Plan: on tobacco and alcohol, on leading-edge research, on imaging...
- A commitment from France to support the development of these actions and to mobilize French actors and researchers

Health democracy

The Strategy was built from:

- Insights from INCa's bodies
- Evaluation report findings
- Contributions from institutional, professional and associative actors
- Large citizens consultations.

Collaboration

Each of the 234 actions is steered by one of the 28 pilots appointed among all stakeholders involved in the fight against cancer.

Accountability

A mid-term evaluation is planned. An annual progress report will be presented to the President of the French Republic and to citizens.

A multi-level governance, involving all key stakeholders



- Chaired by Ministries
- Adopts strategic decisions
- Chaired by INCa
- Ensures operational management
 - Chaired by Ministries / INCa
- Fosters sharing of information

Interministerial committees allow for a stronger coordination with other national policies and plans.
