- UV-filter Methoxypropylamino Cyclohexenylidene Ethoxyethylcyanoacetate (S87) (CAS 1419401-88-9) Submission II. The draft preliminary Opinion is planned to be further discussed and to be finalised at the plenary meeting (26/02).

• Allergy Alert Test (AAT) as a proof-of-concept study to elicit a signal recognisable by laypersons. A progress report was made by the Rapporteur. This Test will be further discussed at the next WG meeting (27/03).
