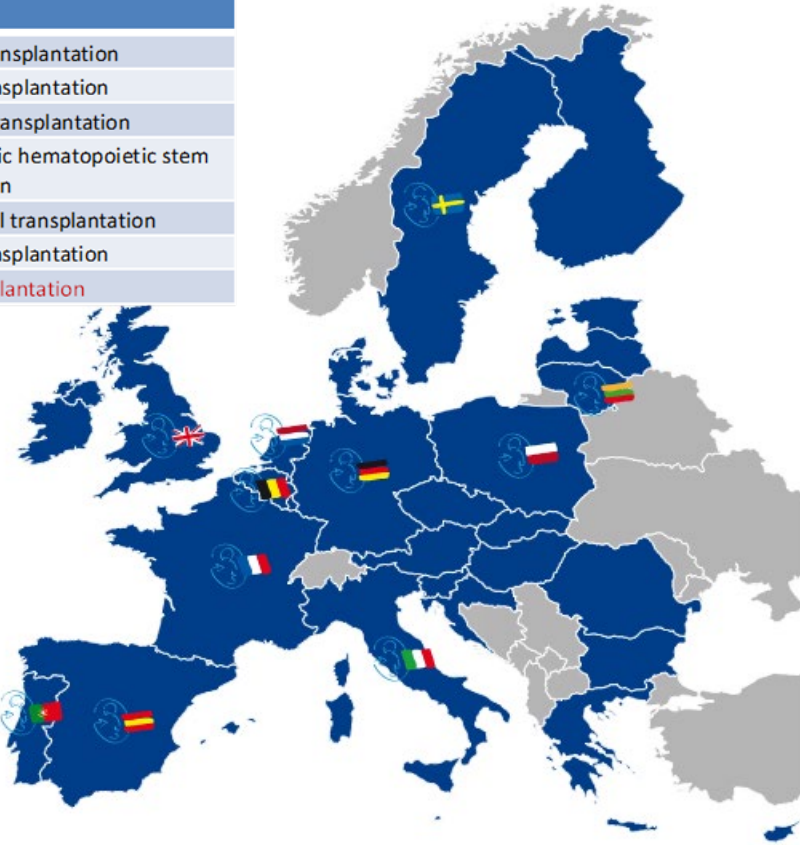

Transplantchild peculiarities:

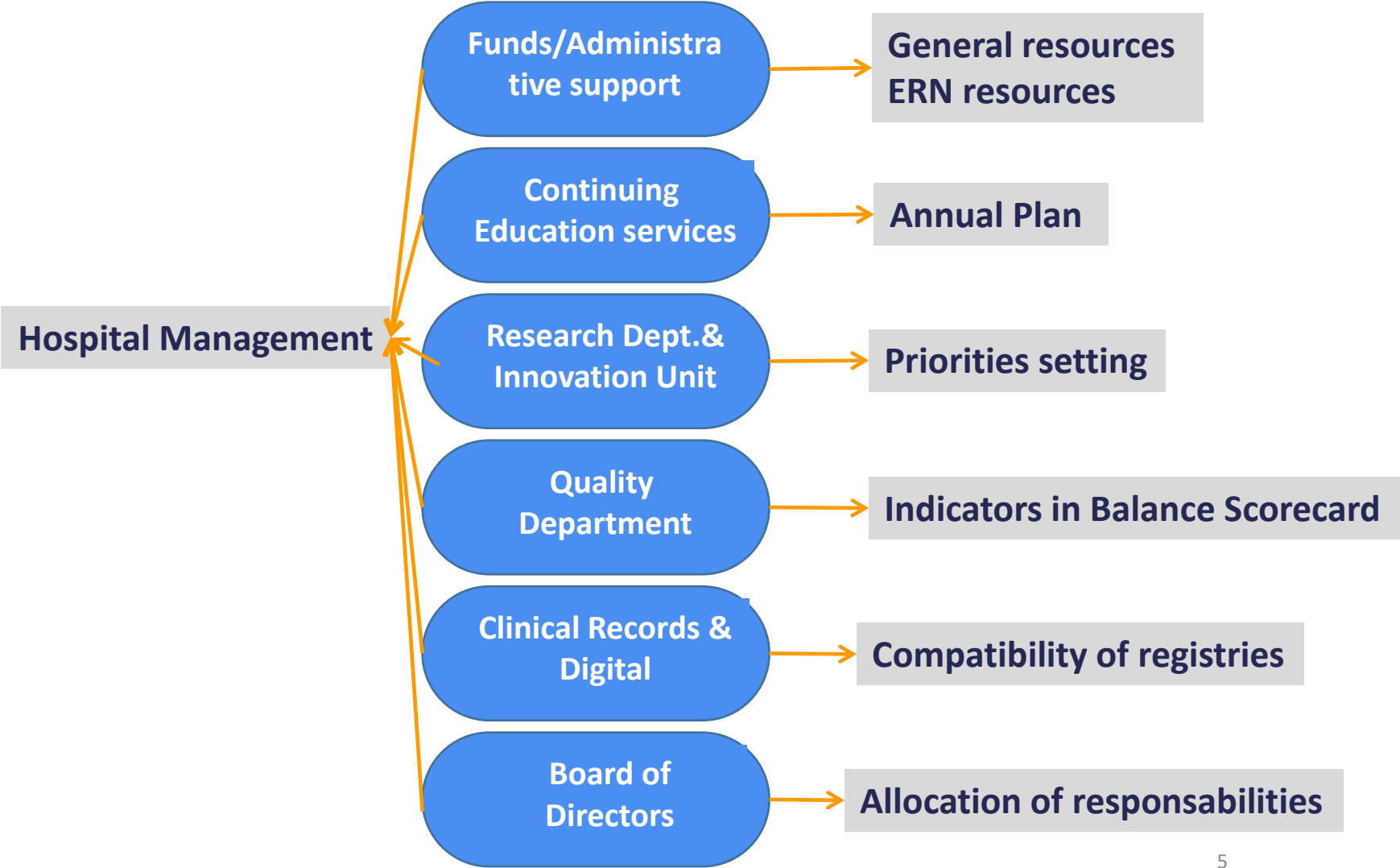
- Complex procedures

- Not for allocation of organs



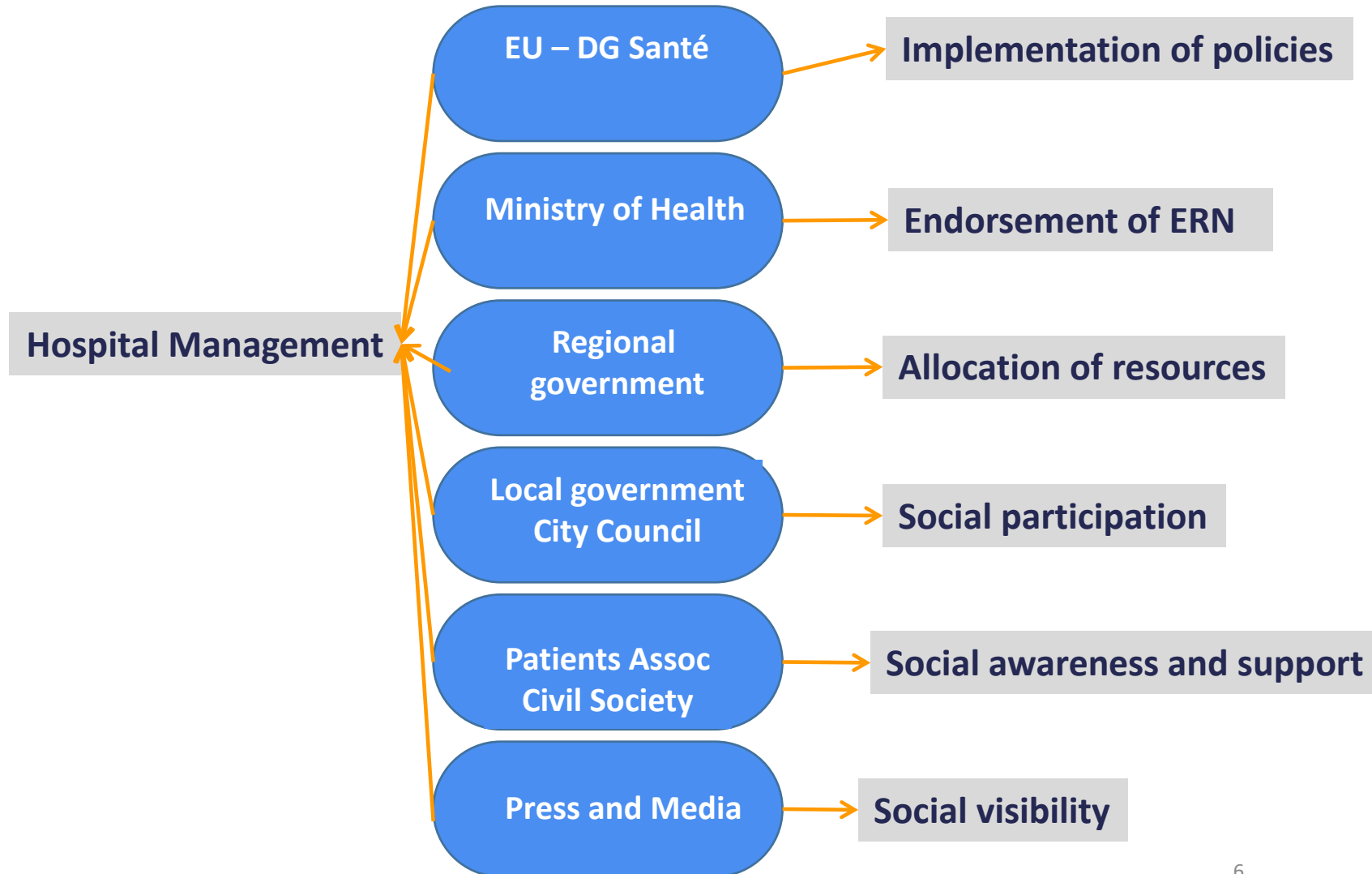
