5. DISCUSSION OF THE OPINION AND DISTRIBUTION OF TASKS.

The discussion focused on several aspects of the text:

- There should be three parts (general principles, methodology, and the tiered approach)
- To do a summary on the relevance of the papers dealing with low doses.
- There should be an introductory chapter which contains clear formulation of the problem including definitions for terms like "mixture of concern", "target population", etc.
- Should there be a separate chapter on endocrine disruptors (low doses)?
- There is agreement for a separate chapter on the specificities of the environmental aspects of chemical mixtures if those aspects go beyond the human-health issues.

- To provide a new text to replace the one on page 9 + to include the text on page 15 on margins of exposure.
- To look up some studies on organophosphates that are related to the studies discussed on page 12.
- To provide a low-dose synergy review paper (page 13).
- To include Jose's part into section 3.3.1.2 (Env.) and to combine both environmental sections into one.
- To consolidate QSAR with CompuTox (page 24 and 25)
- To provide an uncertainty section based on this document:

- The question of how to deal with epidemiological data to be further explored.
