WP4 Objectives (from GA)

General objective

• To support Member States on the implementation of new or innovative policies and practices for empowerment, health promotion and prevention, management of chronic diseases and multimorbidity.

• Specific objectives:

- 1. To support the development and adoption of national, regional and local policies related to health promotion, prevention and innovative management of chronic diseases in their various settings through policy dialogues.
- To support sustainable action planning of Member States to tackle chronic diseases
- 3. Reach consensus of a final position paper ("Consensus Statement") concerning the EU added value of cross-country collaboration in the field of health promotion and prevention and management of chronic diseases and the sustainability of the results from JA-CHRODIS and CHRODIS-PLUS beyond 2020.

Task: To prepare a consensus statement concerning


- 1. the EU added value of cross-country collaboration in the field of CD
- 2. and the sustainability of JA-CHRODIS and CHRODIS-PLUS beyond 2020.

Functional requirements

- A. The document will
 - be based on lessons-learnt from the JA-CHRODIS,
 - making use of the inputs and conclusions from others tasks of the WP4,
 - and other WPs outputs of CHRODIS-PLUS.
- B. The Document must include an analysis on
 - 1. the integration in national policies
 - 2. sustainability of JA-CHRODIS and CHRODIS-PLUS proposals beyond 2020.
 - 3. MS Priorities on CDs control after 2020
- C. The document will also include a Consensus Statement proposal concerning the **EU added value of cross-country collaboration** in the field of CD.

An index proposal (VERY TENTATIVE)

- 1. Vision on exchanging good practices on CD among EU MSs
- 2. Priority action areas
- 3. Sustainability, integration on national policies and EU added value
- 4. Policy targets (consensus statement)
- 5. Operational advices and suggestions
- 6. Strategy to achieve the sustainability and integration on national policies (action plan)



Time planning

- February '19: presentation to SGPP
- Before Summer '19: MS e-survey; first meeting (Webinar) in order to gather inputs (content of the sections and sources); definition of on-line tools
- September '19: Draft structure ready (SGPP consulted on-line)
- October '19: First draft ready for circulation among SGPP
- November '19: Ad hoc meeting (back to back with SGPP)
- By January-February '19: Final draft ready
- Spring '20: Endorsement by SGPP
