There is an urgent need for improving our collective understanding of climate change impacts on health, and for more evidence-based and efficient communication on health risks, cost-efficient solutions and strategies, and effective mitigation and adaptation policies and actions. Within this context, the first purpose of this webinar is to inform you and your colleagues of the European Climate and Health Observatory initiative, led by the European Commission and European Environment Agency, to invite your suggestions and feedback, and to explore opportunities for collaboration and synergies with your work.

Secondly, the webinar is the first official meeting of the European thematic network Climate action through public health education and training, led by the Association of Schools of Public Health in the European Region. The network's activities will lead to a joint statement to be delivered in Q2 2022. All network participants are encouraged to help shape the statement during this first meeting.
