Topic 1.1. Go-live decision to exchange ePrescription and Patient Summary through the eHDSI (Malta, Portugal, and Estonia)

Issue at stake

The aim of this agenda point is for eHealth Network to:

• Issue decisions on go-live applications for: Malta, Portugal, Estonia.

Summary

The procedure for going live and the template for the Recommendation report to go live was adopted by the eHealth Network.

On 16 May 2019, the eHealth DSI Member State Expert Group adopted the Recommendations to the eHealth Network for the three Member States – Malta (PS-A,B), Portugal (PS-A,B, eP-A,B), and Estonia (eP-A) – which have applied to go live, provided that: (1) the Commission auditors confirm that they verified that all the pending recommendations of the audit report have been satisfactorily addressed; (2) the eHDSI Solution Provider confirms that the necessary conformance and functional tests were passed. During the meeting, eHealth Network will decide whether those countries can go-live and under which conditions, if any.

Format of procedure in the eHealth Network meeting

- The Member State co-chair introduces the agenda topic.
- The Member State co-chair invites the eHMSEG chair to present the eHMSEG recommendations and summarise the relevant eHMSEG discussion.
- The Member State co-chair opens the discussion on the go live decisions: the members of the eHealth Network are given the floor for questions and comments.
- The Member State co-chair asks the eHealth Network to vote on the going live applications.
- In accordance with article 7(2) of the eHealth Network's rules of procedure, the vote shall be decided by a majority of two thirds of the network's members present. Each Member State shall have one vote. Absent Member State's vote shall count in the vote if a written mandate is given to another network's member.
