Points for discussion

1. EU guidance on preparing for summer holidays and travel

The document distributed sets the EC position on the issue of COVID-19 and tourism. Beyond the discussion on the paper, we would welcome views on:

- The roadmap on lifting measures argued in favour of taking into account the epidemiological situation in a given Member State. How should this be done for travelling? How can that be done without necessarily/unintentionally discriminating on nationality or residence? What could be the pre-conditions for a more individualised approach? For example: 1) Situation of the country of origin, 2) Individual health status (underlying conditions), 3) Immunity level (if eventually confirmed), 4) Situation in the destination country, etc.
- What specific sectorial or technical guidance will be needed (e.g. restaurants, hotels, museums, travelling, etc.)?
