

Workshop on Exposure Assessment

The aim of this Parallel Session is to review novel approaches in exposure assessment using the results of biomonitoring/biomarker studies; explore ways to make data more available and to identify ways that those results can be/have been incorporated into the risk assessment process.

SUGGESTED ISSUES FOR DISCUSSION

In particular, important aspects which should be considered are the following:

1. What are the ways for assessing human exposures for risk assessment and risk management from an international perspective?
2. How is biomonitoring incorporated in exposure assessment, risk assessment, and risk management?
3. What will be the future collaborative case studies for harmonization of assessing of exposures in the context of risk assessment and risk management?
4. What are the suggestions for further development and harmonization of approaches to exposure assessment?

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
