- Adoption of the Work Plan 2013: <u>02 October 2012</u>
- Publication of the call: <u>Dec 2012</u>
- **Deadline for proposals**: 2nd half <u>March 2013</u>
- New financial regulation: 1st January 2013
 - Award decision: 3rd quarter 2013
 - Closing negotiations: 1st quarter 2014
