

#### **Legal framework**

- Regulation (EC) no 223/2009 on European statistics (11/03/2009)
  - Basis for the development, production and dissemination of statistics within the European statistical system (ESS)
  - Statistical principles / the Code of practice
  - Establishment of the ESSC and ESS-networks
  - Statistical confidentiality/protection and transmission of confidential data
- Regulation (EC) no 1338/2008 on Health & Safety Statistics (16/12/2008)
  - Framework
  - Legal consolidation of existing data collections
  - Integrated implementation of new data collection methodologies



## Causes of death (COD)

- Implementing Regulation
  - Quality improvements:
    - non-residents/residents dying abroad
    - early neo-natal deaths
    - Inclusion of information on stillbirths
  - Revised draft -> TG COD meeting 4-5 May 2010

- Data 2008 -> June 2010:
- Mortality atlas and "Statistics in focus" June 2009
- "Statistics in focus mortality 65 plus" 2010



#### Health care non-expenditure

- Joint data collection with WHO and OECD (from Jan 2010 onwards)
  - Data 1960 2008
  - "Common modules"
    - health employment
    - physical and technical resources inside and outside hospitals (definition according SHA)
  - "Eurostat additional modules"
    - Hospital discharges, procedures, ...
    - Inclusion in joint questionnaire (discussions ongoing)
- Data 2008 -> mid 2010



#### Health care expenditure data

- Joint data collection with OECD and WHO
  - System of Health Accounts (SHA); 2003-2006
  - Health care type of goods and services provided to consumers, health care providers and financing agents
  - Data 2007 -> April 2010; Data 2008 -> End 2010
  - "Statistics in focus" -> 2010
- SHA revision
  - WHO, OECD and Eurostat to improve / extend the current methodology (refining/complementing ICHA classifications)
  - Vivid debate between the three organisations
  - http://www.oecd.org/health/sha/revision
- Start work on an implementing regulation health care (Technical Group Nov 2010)



#### **Disability statistics**

- Health and social integration (EHSI)
- ESSC decision November 2009:
  - A new disability survey within the 2012-2014 period
  - Consider an EP-Council Regulation to ensure financial support
  - Need to streamline information on disability
    (EHSI, EHIS, SILC, LFS ad-hoc module on people with disabilities)



#### **Disability statistics**

- TF on survey based disability statistics (TFDS) established in January 2010
  - Assist Eurostat in developing an EP & Council Regulation
  - Develop recommendations for streamlining
- DSS meeting 11-12 March 2010:
  - Agreement on developing a survey on 'health and social inclusion', taking into account the pilots in 11 Member States (MS) on the EDSIM module
  - Agreement on streamlining
  - Timetable too tight 2012 not feasible for NSI
  - Alternative: a 'boosted' Eurobarometer for 2012
- Next TFDS meeting: 28-29 June 2010



# Disability statistics – Labour Force Survey ad-hoc module 2011.

- Situation of disabled people on the labour market; no intention of measuring prevalence of disability
- Regulation LFS ad-hoc module 2011 passed ESS Committee (Nov 2009) adoption by the Commission in April 2010
- Information on Circa (Regulation, variables, explanatory notes, questionnaire proposal)
- Call for proposals to be launched



## **European Health Interview Survey (EHIS)**

- Wave I
  - 18 countries + TR, CH, NO; 2008-2009
  - 40 indicators; 8 breakdowns
  - First dissemination -> October 2010
- Access to micro data: regulation -> June 2011
- Wave II (2014)
  - Assess Wave I, policy needs, workshop, TG EHIS
  - Link to disability project
  - Regional dimension
  - Implementing regulation (draft 2011->approval 2012)
