## Sub-group on Cancer under the Expert Group on Public Health

# 25 October 2023

The Sub-group on Cancer under the Commission Expert Group on Public Health held a virtual meeting, chaired by DG SANTE. The representatives of 21 Member States, plus Norway, attended the meeting together with several Commission services, and agencies<sup>1</sup> as well as one representative from the European Investment Bank.

Presentation of the 2016 SCHEER Opinion on biological effects of ultraviolet radiation relevant to health with particular reference to sunbeds for cosmetic purposes

A member of the Committee on Health, Environmental and Emerging Risks (SCHEER) presented the main conclusions of the **2016 SCHEER Opinion**<sup>2</sup>: <u>Presentation of the legal aspects under the Low Voltage Directive concerning sunbeds</u>

DG GROW gave a presentation on the legal aspects concerning sunbeds under the **Low Voltage Directive** (LVD).<sup>3</sup> The LVD regulates the health and safety of electrical products operating at certain voltage when placed on the EU market, including sunbeds.

<u>Presentation of the preliminary results of the survey carried out with the Cancer Subgroup of the PHEG as regards to national measures on the use of sunbeds in Member</u> <u>States and EFTA countries</u>

An overview on preliminary results of the survey on to map the situation as regards sunbeds in Member States was given. The deadline for responding to the survey has been extended to the 5 November 2023.

<u>Open discussion on content of the Commission's Recommendation on reducing</u> <u>human risks associated with the use of sunbeds</u>

Participants exchanged their views on the possible recommendations on reducing human health risks associated with the use of sunbeds.

#### Update on the European Cancer Patient Digital Centre

DG RTD gave an update on the development of the **European Cancer Patient Digital Centre** and informed the participants about a final workshop.
