# EU4Health Programme 2021-2027 – Joint Actions (AWP 2021)

# Eligible legal entities (Art. 13.5)

Under the Programme, direct grants may be awarded without a call for proposals to fund actions, if such grants are duly justified, and if those actions have a Union added value that is explicitly provided for in the annual work programmes and are co-financed by

- the competent authorities that are responsible for health in the Member States or in third countries associated to the Programme,
- by relevant international health organisations,
- by public sector bodies or non governmental bodies that are mandated by those competent authorities, regardless of whether those bodies act individually or as a network.

# Participation

- One competent authority per MS/ participating country per JA
- Inclusion of the proposed affiliated entities in the nomination process
