3 pillars for ERN sustainability

- Sharing data & knowledge
- Better care & outcomes
- Patients & Society



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Sharing Data and Knowledge



Challenges

- Different classifications (ICD10,Orphanet...)
- Admin tasks, workforce, Burn-out
- Triple registration (EU, National, regional...)
- Different languages
- Different ERNs in a not connected intra-center.

Possibilities/opportunities

- Standardized classification for the EU (Universal coding)
- Automated extraction clinical data, allocated resources.
- Harmonized registries and interoperability.
- Natural language processing → artificial intelligence
- Join efforts and knowledge by creating a shared virtual structure, patient agendas, information systems within the hospital.
- Local ERN interdisciplinary members network.

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Better care & outcomes

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Challenges

- Heterogeneous care pathways...variability
- No outcomes measured: Clinical, PROMs & PREMs
- Non patient centred care and organizational culture
- Knowledge about what to do but ... how to do it? How to embed it in the daily activity?
- How to improve the current care
- ERNs focused on the clinical condition, Hospital KPIs (efficiency vs. Quality).

Possibilities/opportunities

- ERN Clinical Guidelines and Process
- Measure outcomes in terms of health and experience.
- Organizational innovation. One time, one place, multiple specialists. Pediatric to adult transition.
- Design and measure processes, patient pathways and organizational structure.
- **ERN beyond healthcare**: Research, training and innovation.
- Creation of a Hospital ERN Managers Network, involving hospitals and public administration for commitment.

Patients & Society

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Challenges

- Induced demand why is it happening
- Despite highly specialized attention, primary care plays a role (not only in the follow-up)
- Inequality in access

High costs for diagnosis and treatment (Orphan drugs)

Possibilities/opportunities

- Communication guidelines, training professionals and society.
- Involving Primary Care and Social Care. Dissemination and promotion beyond the hospital.
- Patients associations advocacy and stakeholders commitment. Co-design: managers and PAGs collaboration for prioritizing hospital actions.
- The role of the Pharmaceutical Industry: **shared financing, pay per value, risk sharing**... Public procurement of innovation.
