## Article 29 **Governance**

“The Commission shall consult the health authorities of the Member States in the Steering Group on Health Promotion, Disease Prevention and Management of Non-Communicable Diseases or in other relevant Commission expert group or similar entities

on the work plans established for the Health strand and its priorities and strategic orientations and its implementation,

and also on the health policy perspective of other policies and support mechanisms, thus increasing their overall coordination and added value.”

## For the Health strand

Consult the **health authorities** in the **Steering Group**

- **on the work plans** established for the Health strand and if necessary deliberate
- its **priorities and strategic orientations** and
- its **implementation**
- and on possibilities **to upscale best practices through ESF+shared management strand.**

# On the other policies and supporting mechanisms

Advise the Commission at an **earlier stage** of the preparation of the work plans

and aiming at **coordination** of initiatives **across programs.**

Without replacing their specific governance, SGPP could be consulted on the health policy perspective of other policies and support mechanisms, also involving other groups if needed.

# Article 32 **Work Programme and Coordination**

“ The Commission shall

**foster synergies and ensure effective coordination between the Health strand of ESF+**

**and the Reform Support Programme, including the Reform Delivery Tool and the Technical Support Instrument.”**

# Examples of coordination

The SGPP has already been effective in supporting concrete collaboration

- **Colorectal cancer screening funded by SRSS**
- **Joint initiative with the European Investment Bank on proton therapy centres**
- **Screening of implementable research results with RTD**
- **Best practice assessment with the JRC.**

# Composition and scope

Composed of Member State representatives nominated by their **health authorities**.

Current **scope** can be adapted as necessary.
