- TiO<sub>2</sub> new coatings. The Applicant sent reply to the SCCS letter. The WG will continue drafting the opinion with the current data.
- Hydroxyapatite (HAP). Some clarification has been received but there are some open questions. The Secretariat sent Email to the Applicant to come back as soon as possible.
- TiO<sub>2</sub> preliminary scientific advice from WG cosmetics
  - o SCCS discussed points sent by Cosmetics Europe. A letter will be finalised at the next meeting of the WG on cosmetic ingredients.
