• Aim; Understand how neuroendocrine regulation of fat mass offer redundant adaptations to preserve fat mass whenever recommendations of physical activity and nutrition is sought accomplished.

• Context: Obesity as a chronic disease causing numerous medical and psychosocial complications.

• Aim; Investigate and integrate the impact of nutrition and physical activity advices upon the effect upon obesity related complications and potentially cancer in adulthood.

• Context; Excessive weight gain during pregnancy is associated with increased birth weight and early childhood obesity.

• Aim; Investigate the psycho-social factors contributing to excessive gestational weight gain and to the development of early childhood obesity.
