Elements of the EU Cancer Plan

- Holistic across the entire disease pathway
- Whole of government approach/Health in all policies
- Address Health inequalities
- UN Sustainable Development Goals and WHO targets on non-communicable diseases
- Positive effect on other non-communicable diseases with similar health determinants
- Lessons learnt from Covid-19
- Linkages with other Commission priorities (Cancer Mission, Pharmaceutical strategy, EHDS, f2f, Green Deal etc.)



EU Cancer Plan proposes actions for all stages of the disease

PREVENTION

4 out of every 10 cases of cancer are preventable. The Plan will draw attention to:

- role of nutrition, physical activity, tobacco and alcohol
- vaccination
- reducing exposure to carcinogens in the work place and in the environment
- European Code against Cancer



EU Cancer Plan proposes actions for all stages of the disease

EARLY DIAGNOSIS

- Screening recommendations
- Continued work on guidelines
- Data interoperability, pooling of data, use of AI (EHDS)

TREATMENT

- Improve access to treatment (timely, innovative, affordable)
- Improve (specialist) training of health professionals
- Enhance EU networking (treatment centres, exchange of best practices)
- Enhance registries

QUALITY OF LIFE & SURVIVORS

- Improving quality of life for patients and survivors
- Avoiding discrimination
- Psychological support
- Back-to-work support
