Dr. von Goetz is senior scientist and exposure specialist at the Swiss Federal Office of Public Health and lecturer at the Swiss Federal Institute of Technology Zurich (ETH Zurich). Chemist by training, she worked in industry from 1997-2007 in the area of environmental exposure modelling. From 2008-2018 she was leading a research group for modelling consumer exposure to chemicals of concern at ETH.

Her research interests encompass the development of methodology for consumer exposure modelling, assessing aggregate consumer exposure to chemicals of concern (e.g. EDCs, sensitizers, nanoparticles) as well as translating academic insights into information useful for decision makers. As an external expert for exposure science she is contributing regularly to the risk assessment of chemicals and method development at European governmental authorities, such as the European Food Safety Agency (EFSA) and the scientific committee on consumer safety (SCCS).
