

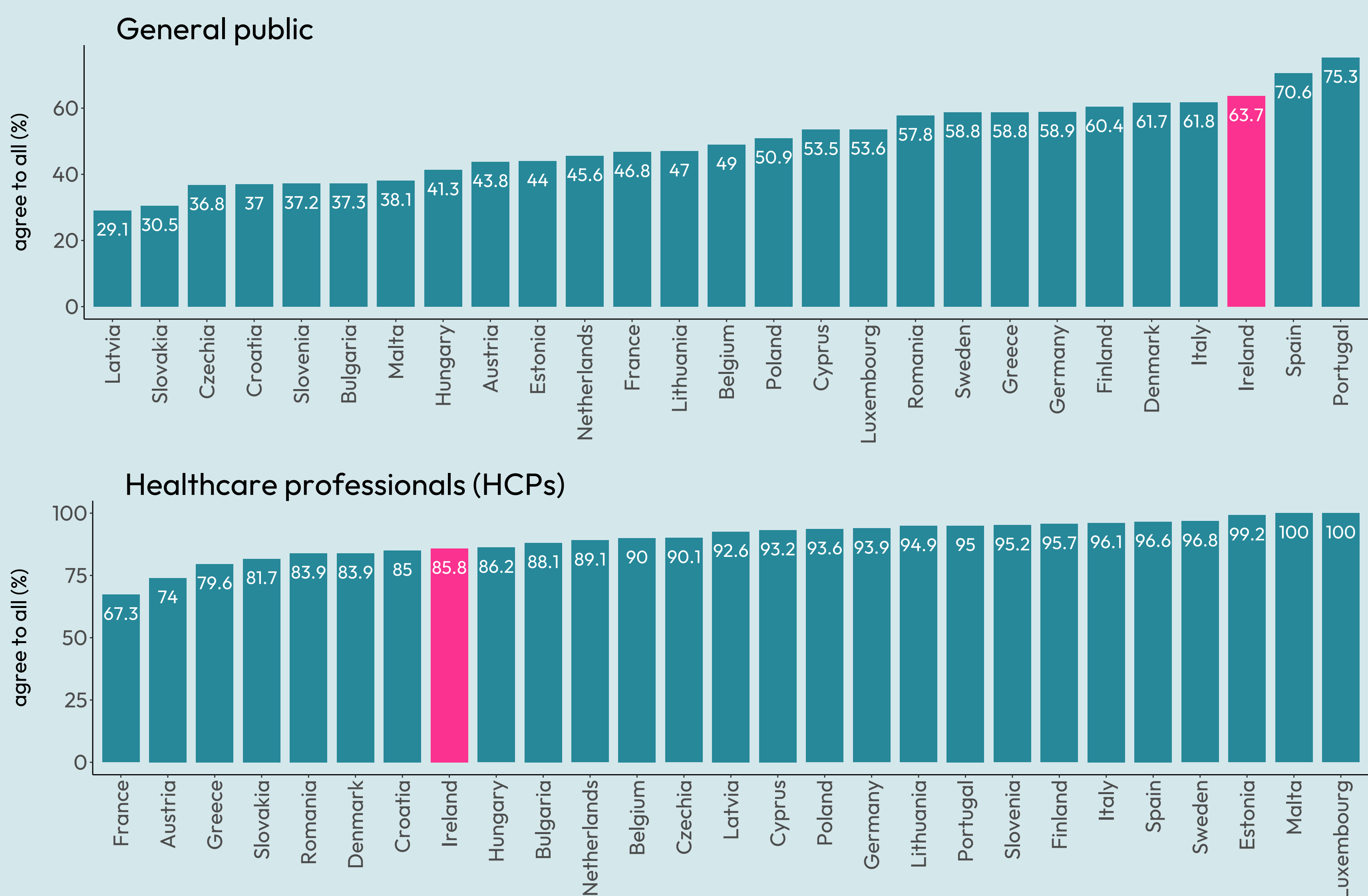

Importance and safety confidence and change* since 2020

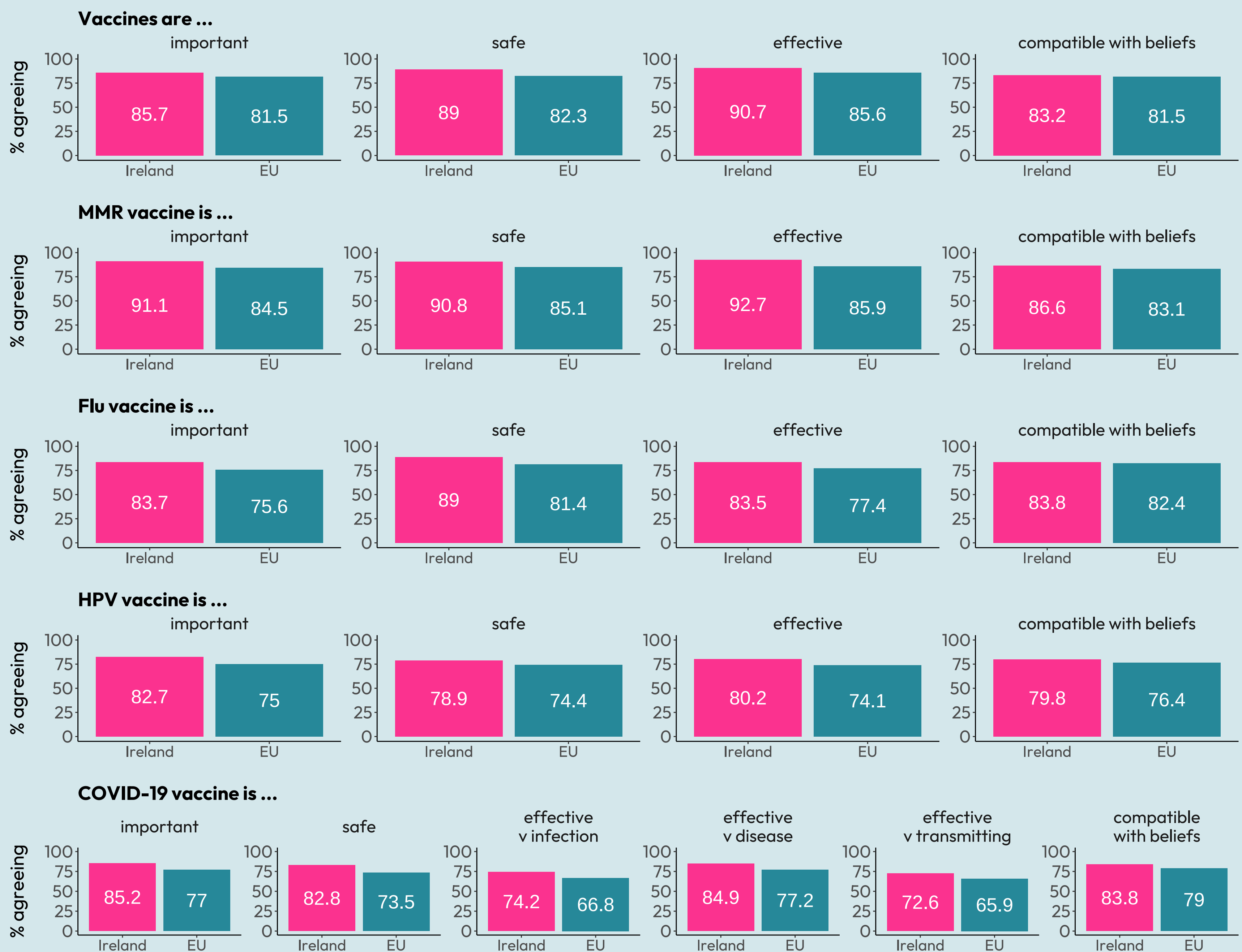
Vaccines are safe: 89% (no change)
 Vaccines are important: 85.7% (-5.1pp change)

MMR vaccine is safe: 90.8% (+4.7pp change)
 MMR vaccine is important: 91.1% (+2.7pp change)

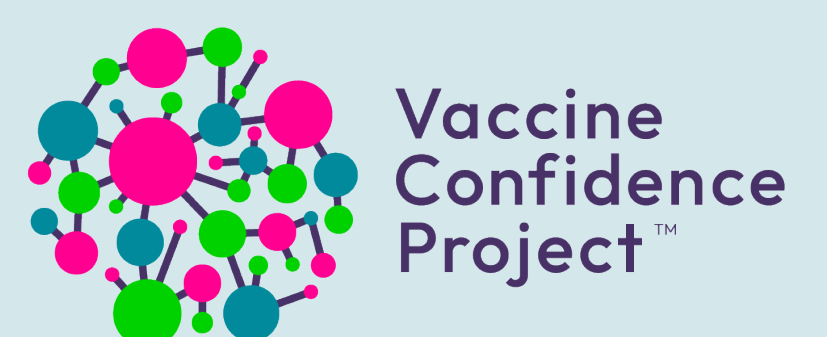
Flu vaccine is safe: 89% (+5.2pp change)
 Flu vaccine is important: 83.7% (no change)

HPV vaccine is safe: 78.9% (no change)
 HPV vaccine is important: 82.7% (no change)

 COVID-19 vaccine is important: 85.2% (no 2020 data)

99.7% would recommend flu vaccine to patients

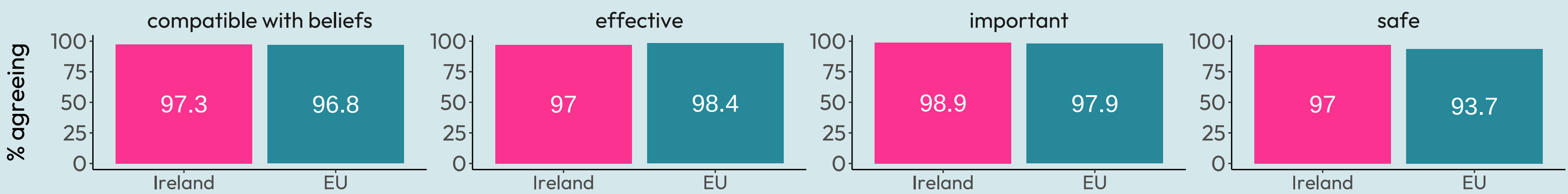
86.9% would recommend flu vaccine to pregnant women

98.9% would recommend HPV vaccine to patients

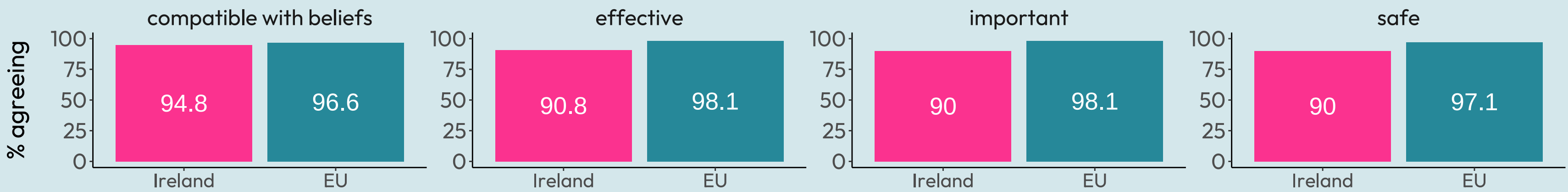
98.5% would recommend COVID-19 vaccine to patients

88.4% would recommend COVID-19 vaccine to pregnant women

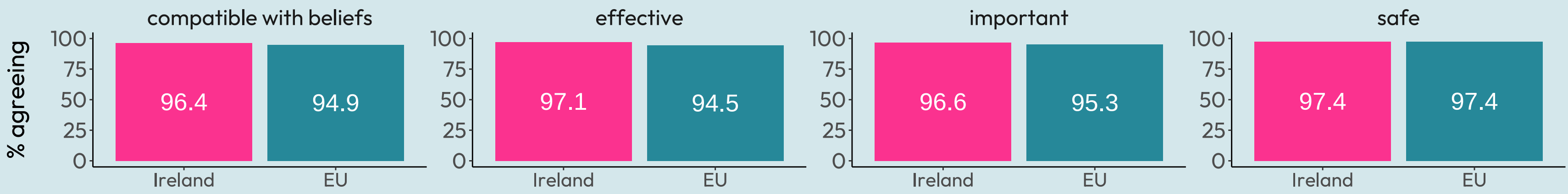

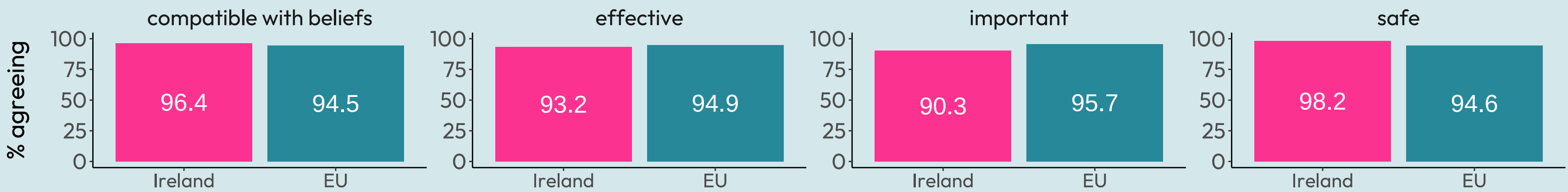
