#### **Overarching Pres Priorities in EU Health Policy**

- managing the COVID-19-crisis
- creating more resilient health systems
- returning to interinstitutional best practices in the EU
- covering health priorities not directly linked to the crisis

### main fora for policy making

from October 2020	Special European Council meetings on COVID-19 (VC, starting 29 October)
September and October 2020	three special meetings of EU health ministers on COVID-19 and WHO reform (VC)
2 December 2020	Formal EU Health Ministers Council
whole Presidency	around 20 meetings of CWP Health and Pharma and 20 meetings of IPCR crisis management

#### Council files already achieved or on track

- EU regulation on GMO procedures for COVID-19-vaccines development finalization in July 2020 clarifies some open questions and safeguards vaccine development processes
- new EU health program EU4health for 2021-2027
  general alignment of Council for trilogue with EP agreed on 21 October 2020 –
  main points: governance, priority areas and financial volume
- Council recommendation on COVID-19-coordination agreed in written procedure in October 2020 main points: classification of risk areas, recommendations for cross-border movement of persons in EU, list of essential travel purposes
- Council conclusions on WHO strengthening (planned November 2020)
   political agreement on EU priorities for WHO strengthening main points:
   pandemic response, new structures, better cooperation
- [Vaccines advance purchase agreements] cooperation COM/member states

#### Council files still to be negotiated

- Council Conclusions on lessons-learned from COVID-19
  main areas: pandemic preparedness, pharmaceutical shortages, European Health
  Data Space, implications for health systems, global health
- (poss.): New Council Recommendations on COVID-19-coordination likely topics: quarantine and testing, vaccination, coordination of national measures
- proposal for a EU-HTA regulation continuation of negotiations since January 2018
- proposal for new mandates for ECDC and EMA COM proposal expected for mid-November

# **EU-HTA:** core problems negotiated in the Council

- binding nature of EU-HTA assessments
   flexibility for implementation in national health systems; suitability of an escape clause vs.
   stronger reference to national health competence
- challenging of EU-HTA assessments at courts
   defining the EU-HTA assessment as preparatory act or as an adminstrative decision; opening
   a possibility to challenge the EU decision at European Courts; risk of overshadowing national
   court procedures
- decision-making processes in the member states coordination Group
  possibility of votes on scientific questions vs. consensus principle in science; introduction of
  simple majority, two-thirds majority or qualified majority with reference to the population
  size of member states
- scope of the EU-HTA regulation
   pharmaceuticals: covering all products authorized by EMA vs. selection of about 10 products
   a year; medical devices: selection criteria taking into account differences in market
   authorization

#### **EU-HTA:** next steps and timelines

- November 2020 compromise proposal of DEU Presidency
- November /December 2020
   Council Working Party Pharma discusses the compromise
- 2 December 2020
   HTA progress report at EPSCO Health Ministers Council
- follow-up procedure I/2021 to be defined by Portuguese Presidency
