Criteria for best practices on non-communicable diseases adopted by the SGPP

June 2019

SGPP agreement to select “best practices in view of how EU Member States incite parents to make their children have childhood vaccines in general and the 2nd dose of the measles vaccine in particular”



Need to revise the criteria to cover also communicable diseases, vaccination, other EU health priorities (cancer, AMR, climate change & health)

October-December 2019

Revision of the criteria by:

- experts
- the Health Security Committee (HSC)

Can the SGPP adopt the revised criteria?

The way forward:

- Collaboration with the EU-JAV (country-level survey on interventions to address vaccine hesitancy)
- Owners of “best practice candidates” to submit interventions to the Best Practice Portal
- Marketplace to be organized in view of country-to-country transfer of best practices (foreseen for June 2020)
