## ‘Small Countries’ Health Information Network

- Initiative of the Minister of Health, Malta;
- 8 countries established dedicated health information network;
- Malta chairing the network in phase 1;
- Second meeting held in Monaco on 12 ${ }^{\text {th }}$ October 2016;

- Agreement on reporting of 'rolling average' of selected indicators;
- Developing joint indicator list for reporting on HSPA and Health 2020.



## EVIPNet Europe: growing rapidly



- Promotes systematic use of research evidence in policy-making;
- Increases country capacity in developing sound and effective health policies;
- Institutionalizes knowledge translation (KT)

Funding plus JPO from Germany
(totalling Euros 500 K ) through the establishment of KT country teams;

- SCHIN expressed interest in network activity.



## Brand-new! European Burden of Disease Network

- Chaired by Public Health England (Prof John Newton); co-chaired by The Netherlands;
- First meeting of EBoDN 20-21 September 2016 in London with 10 countries;
- Hosted jointly with the Institute of Health Metrics \& Evaluation (IHME);
- Terms of Reference and work plan for network agreed;
- National burden of disease manual in preparation;
- Editorial in European Journal of Public Health.
