Two Options for Deploying FMTs



Ad-hoc basis

MS can inform the ERCC of any available medical teams or experts ready to deploy

MS bear the costs (possible grant for up to 55% transport)

The offer must be registered in the Common Emergency Communication and Information System (CECIS)



European Emergency Response Capacity

The voluntary pool is a system whereby Member States can pre-commit response capacities for EU missions



In return for this commitment, Member States benefit from financial support for adapting and transporting these capacities



The quality of the assistance is ensured through the establishment of quality criteria and a certification process
