Mission on Cancer – consulting citizens- first outcomes

Information for citizens/Prevention

- Role for EU on awareness, seen as source of reliable information
- Promote health/cancer education in schools
- Promote **health literacy**: healthy nutrition/lifestyles, symptoms' identification, screening possibilities

Treatment/Care

- Closer collaboration with general practitioners
- Support for the patient navigating the cancer pathway (Navigator)

Survivorship Psychological support

Equity Role for EU to **address inequities**: access to screening, care Differences in **cities** versus **rural cancer care**
