



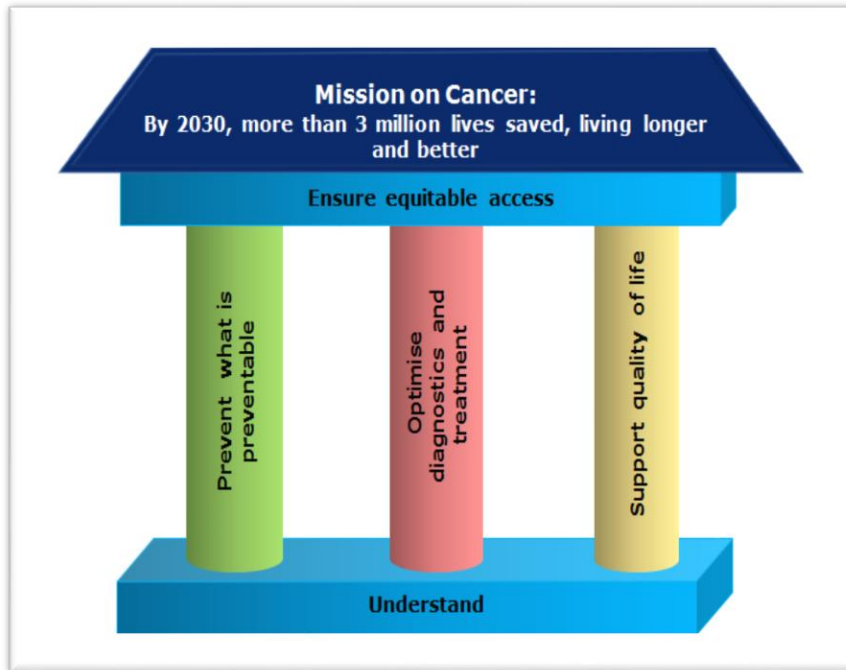

Mission on Cancer – consulting citizens- first outcomes

Information for citizens/Prevention

- **Role for EU** on awareness, seen as **source of reliable information**
- Promote **health/cancer education in schools**
- Promote **health literacy**: healthy nutrition/lifestyles, symptoms' identification, screening possibilities

Treatment/Care

- Closer collaboration with **general practitioners**
- **Support** for the patient **navigating the cancer pathway** (Navigator)

Psychological support

Role for EU to **address inequities**: access to screening, care
