Developments in the Netherlands

- Pharmacy preparations are a solution for medicines that (1) temporarily or (2) permanently are not available (anymore) on the Dutch market with a marketing authorization.
- Both products for community pharmacies and hospital pharmacies.
- Large diversity of products, including important/critical medicines.
- For individual patients, but also for larger patient groups.

Developments in the Netherlands

- Use of pharmacy preparations is common in the Netherlands; it forms an integral part in the availability of medicines for patients.
- A trend towards concentration of preparation activities is visible in the Netherlands -> not every pharmacy is able or willing to prepare (all) pharmacy preparations needed.
- Provides opportunities for quality improvements; raises challenges on safeguards quality and outsourcing.
