- Research, innovation

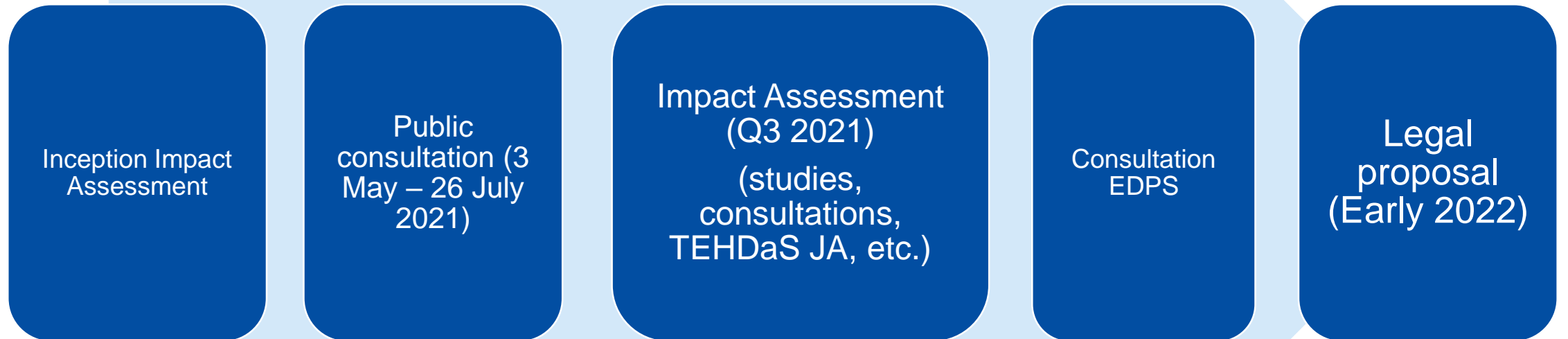

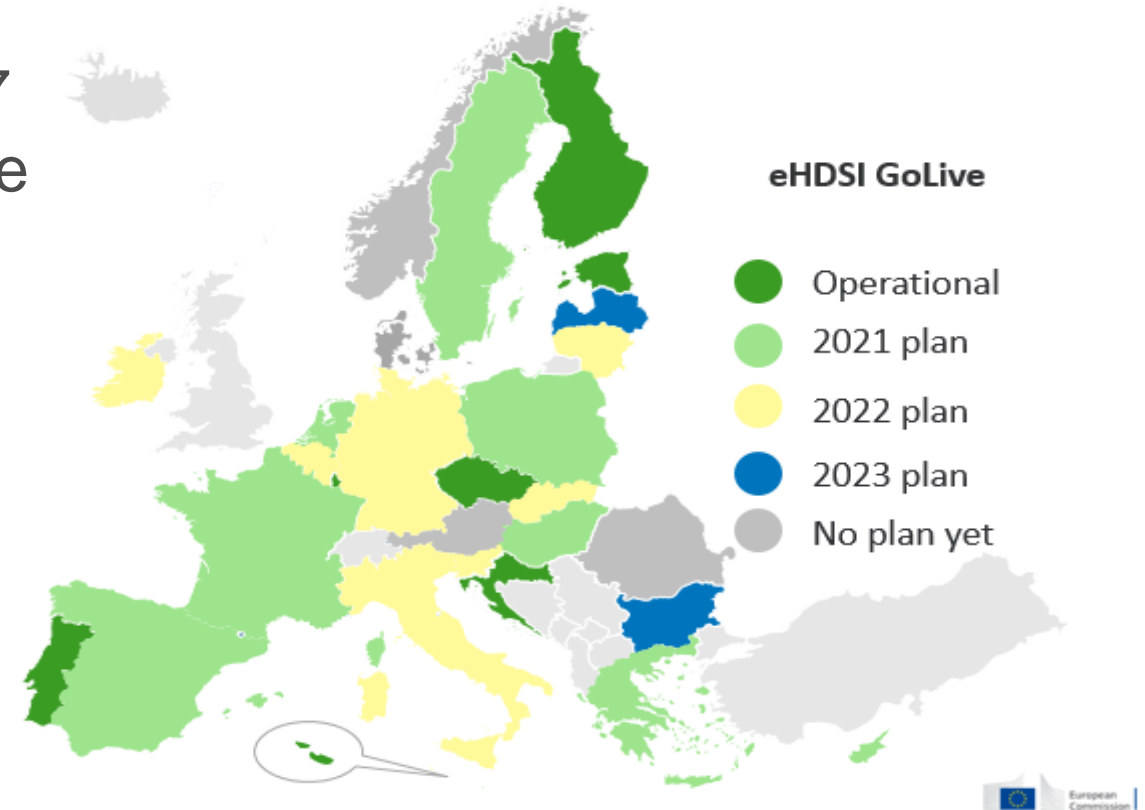

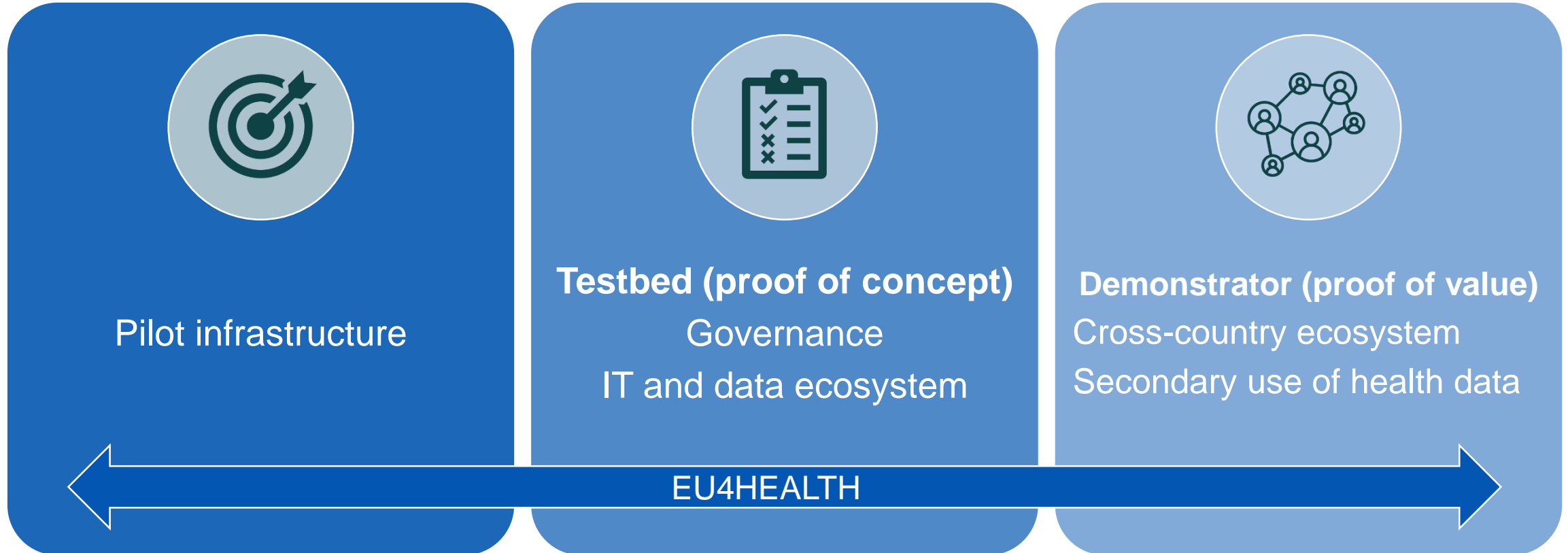

# EHDS1: MyHealth@EU: cross-border exchange of patients' data

- Patient summaries and ePrescriptions: 7 Member States currently live; more in the process of onboarding in 2021/2022
- Beyond 2021: new services for images, laboratory results, discharge reports
- Access of patients to their health data

# TEHDaS Joint Action

- The project develops joint European principles for the secondary use of health data.
- It involves 25 countries.
- Several strands of work:
  - Dialogue about the EHDS
  - Sustainability of secondary uses of health data
  - Governance model for cross-border co-operation in the secondary use of health data
  - Reliability and compatibility of and access to health data for secondary use;
  - Role of individuals in the secondary use of health data

# EU4Health and the EHDS

- *Strengthen health systems so that they can face epidemics as well as long-term challenges by stimulating*
  - *disease prevention and health promotion in an ageing population*
  - **digital transformation of health systems**
  - access to health care for vulnerable groups

- **Preparation of the impact assessment**
  - Consultations and studies ongoing
  - **Open public consultation open for input (May-July 2021)**
- **Legislative proposal** on the European Health Data Space in early 2022
- Cooperation with Member States and stakeholders in the **Towards a European Health Data Space (TEHDaS)** Joint Action
