

### 2.- Prevention

- HPV vaccination: successful strategy
  - Vaccine coverage first dose = 89,5% (2019)
  - Vaccine coverage second dose = 79% (2019)

# Screening:

- Breast cancer screening programme: coverage > 90% and participation > 85%
- Colorectal cancer screening programme: progressing towards full coverage nationwide
- Cervical cancer screening: from opportunistic (primary care based) to population-bases screening
- Lung cancer screening: again being evaluated by RedTES including a cost-effectiveness analysis



# 3.- Health care

- Model of Cancer Care organization based on multidisciplinary care
- Development of a model of Reference Centres/Units for rare tumours within the NHS: adults and childhood
- Paediatric oncology: Agreement among regions to centralize the units, with indicators based on volume, quality and outcomes to improve the variability in survival observed among regions in the Spanish Paediatric Tumour Registry
- Psychological care for cancer patients: validation of short and simple evidence-based tools to detect emotional distress early (RedETS)
- COVID-19 pandemic and cancer: Agreement among regions to establish priorities in order to improve health care for cancer patients during COVID-19 pandemic
- Genomic basket services :
  - Review of the current common genetic basket services
  - Development of a genomic services catalogue, including diagnostic, prognostic and predictive cancer biomarkers
  - Define the organizational and care model to ensure equity, efficiency and cohesion in the NHS.



# 4.- Allignement with EBCP

- Communication campaign for the dissemination of the European Code against cancer:
  - Radio and digital media
  - Funded by NextGenerationUE







- Recovery and Resilience Funds: 4 million euros transferred to regions in 2021 for screening programs (colon and cervical cancer)
- Survivorship: individualized follow-up plan after finishing treatment + specific coordinated circuites between primary care and hospital services

# 5.- EU4Health

- Spanish participation in 4 Joint Actions related to cancer:
  - Preparatory activities on creation of National Comprehensive Cancer Centres and EU Networking
  - Establishment of new EU Network of Expertise on Cancers and Cancer Conditions
  - Strengthening eHealth, integrating telemedicine and remote monitoring in health and care systems for cancer prevention and care
  - Action grants to support actions to improve access to human papillomavirus vaccination
