Sub-group on Cancer under the Expert Group on Public Health 17 November 2023

The Sub-group on Cancer under the Commission Expert Group on Public Health (PHEG) held a virtual meeting, chaired by DG SANTE. The representatives of 19 Member States, plus Norway, attended the meeting together with several Commission services, and agencies¹ as well as one representative from the WHO Collaborative Centre for UV Radiation.

<u>Presentation of the WHO guidance on artificial tanning devices</u>

A member of the WHO Collaborative Centre for UV Radiation gave a presentation on the **2017 WHO guidance on artificial tanning devices**². In particular, an overview of the risks and effects of sunbed use and policy options to decrease health risks from sunbeds was given.

Presentation of the results of the survey carried out with the Cancer Sub-group of the PHEG as regards to national measures, in place or planned, on the use of sunbeds in Member States and EFTA countries.

A presentation of the final results of the **survey** to map the situation as regards national measures in place or planned to reduce human health risks related to sunbeds usage was given.

<u>Presentation of the preliminary analysis of the results of the Call for Evidence on feedback as regards to the proposed Commission Recommendation on reducing human risks associated with the use of sunbeds</u>

An overview of the preliminary results of the **Call for Evidence**³ lunched by the Commission on October 9th, was given. Through this Call for Evidence, the Commission aims to gather views on how the future Recommendation may achieve the objectives set out collecting views on its expected impacts.

<u>Presentation of the preliminary results of the literature review covering the period after the SCHEER Opinion on sunbeds (2016)</u>

New evidence emerged since the 2016 SCHEER Opinion⁴ was presented.
