As the humanitarian situation in Ukraine worsens and neighbouring countries receive Ukrainian refugees fleeing their country, the European Commission is working on all fronts to provide emergency assistance.

On 4 March, the Commission organised a webinar on the Health Policy Platform to open up discussion on how to best coordinate efforts and collaborate. 350 stakeholders registered for this event, and participants overwhelmingly voiced interest in having a dedicated network. Just hours after the webinar, the "Supporting Ukraine, neighbouring EU Member States and Moldova" network was set up.

We want to keep all stakeholders informed about the support activities and official mechanisms established at EU level and we are continuing to explore different initiatives to create synergy.
