

## Areas for cooperation

- 1. Health information provision to support the SGPP prioritised activities:
- Advising on relevant health information needs and providing regularly updated health intelligence;
- Advising on the quality and interpretation of health data and information;
- Acting as a platform for cooperation and collaboration on providing and exchanging information, and creating synergies among data / knowledge producers and users.



### Areas for cooperation

- 2. Measurement tools for monitoring and on transferability of best practices selected by the SGPP:
- Facilitate the use of pertinent projects and networks.
- Supporting international organizations in defining health indicators to monitor member countries' progress towards implemented best practices.
- Supporting where relevant the SGPP in their objective to help Member States to reach the Sustainable Development Goal 3.



### Areas for cooperation

## 3. Identification of research gaps in public health:

- Advising on research needs in the field of health information / data;
- Advising on how to use already existing but insufficiently used research data and results for better health intelligence.




#### Potential deliverables

- 1. Health information analysis as intelligence to the SGPP.
- 2. New indicators or improved existing indicator sets.
- 3. Reports on indicator collection needs.
- 4. Cross-national case studies/best practices on public health surveillance or research analysis.
- 5. Roadmap to support methodology developments, incl. better methods and tools.
- 6. Mapping and analysing of ongoing research efforts on health information, identification of research gaps.
- 7. Reports on MS' progress towards UN/WHO targets.




### Methodological approach on NCDs targets






