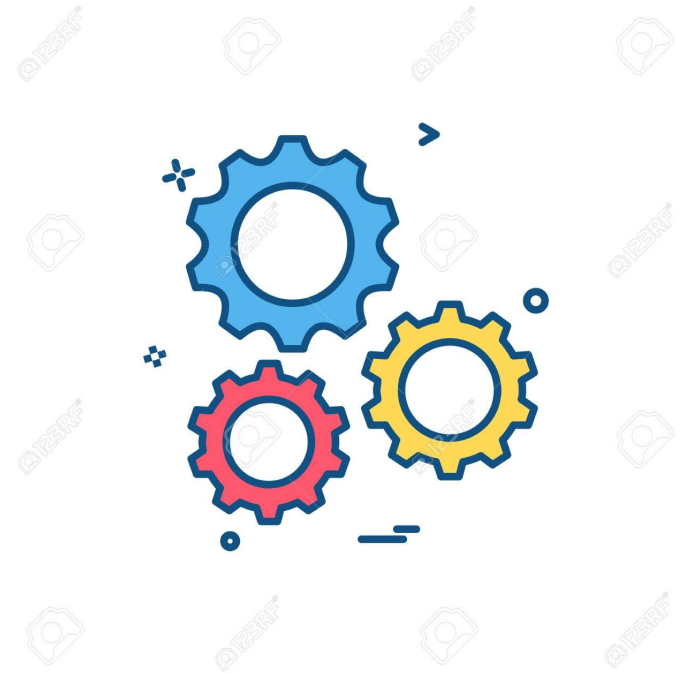

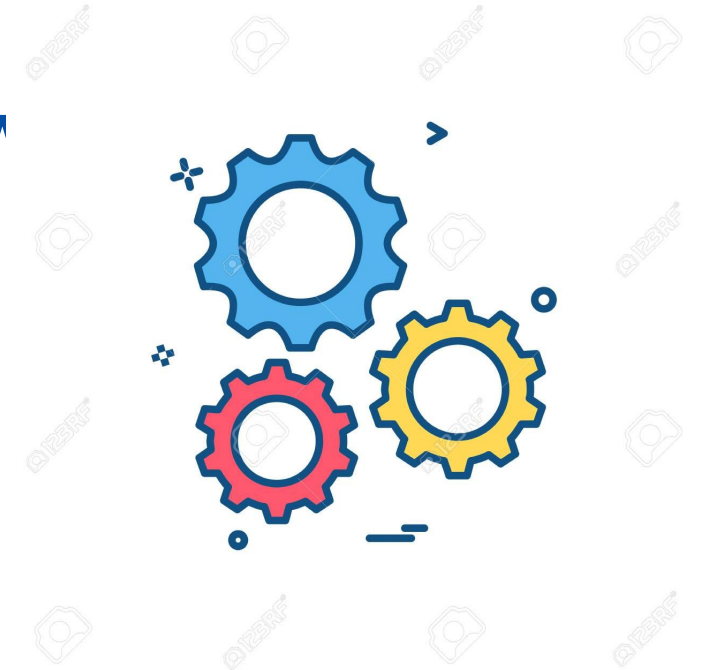
# What is the review tool?

This tool will be used for the **documentary review** of the NAPs.

It aims to:

- *Minimise the burden on MS*
- Guide and promote a **common approach** by reviewers (uniformity)

\*We do not intend to look at implementation

# Structure

- It is divided into **sections / main working areas** containing the elements to be looked at
- Where relevant, the sections are also divided by sectors to capture the One Health purpose of the document(s) (Human, animal, plant & environment)

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# Structure

The first two sections are related to horizontal aspects of the NAP (governance and coordination)

The remaining sections relate to the objectives included in the WHO Global Action Plan.
