- an opinion on methyl salicylate to be included in CLP as CMR Cat. 2
- a scientific advice on methyl-N-methylantranilate (phototoxicity)

## 2.2 Draft Opinion discussed

- **BPA in clothing** – A revised draft text has been discussed and new contribution tasks have been allocated to members. A revised draft of the preliminary version should be finalised during the next WG meeting (06/10).
- **Benzophenone-3** – A revised draft text has been discussed and additional data have been received. New contribution tasks have been allocated to members and DG GROW will extend the deadline in the mandate until mid-January. A revised draft of the preliminary version will be discussed during the next WG meeting (06/10).
- **Homosalate** - A revised draft text has been discussed and new contribution tasks have been allocated to members. A revised draft of the preliminary version should be finalised during the next WG meeting (06/10).
- **Resorcinol** - A revised draft text has been discussed. The draft should be finalised during the next WG meeting (06/10).
- **Propylparaben** – A revised draft text has been discussed and new contribution tasks have been allocated to members. A revised draft of the preliminary version should be finalised during the next WG meeting (06/10).
- **Octocrylene** - A revised draft text has been discussed and additional data have been (and will still be) received. New contribution tasks have been allocated to members and DG GROW will extend the deadline in the mandate until mid-January. A revised draft of the preliminary version will be discussed during the next WG meeting (06/10).
- **Hair Dye Acid Yellow 3** – C054 – the opinion is ON HOLD until November 2020 due to request sent to the Applicant.
- **Scientific advice on methyl-N-methylantranilate** (phototoxicity): a draft has been prepared for comments and discussion. The final version of the scientific advice will be prepared for presentation at the next WG meeting and for adoption by written procedure.

- **TiO<sub>2</sub> (non nano)**: comments have been received and discussed among the members. The SCCS responses and a final version of the Opinion will be prepared for adoption by written procedure.
