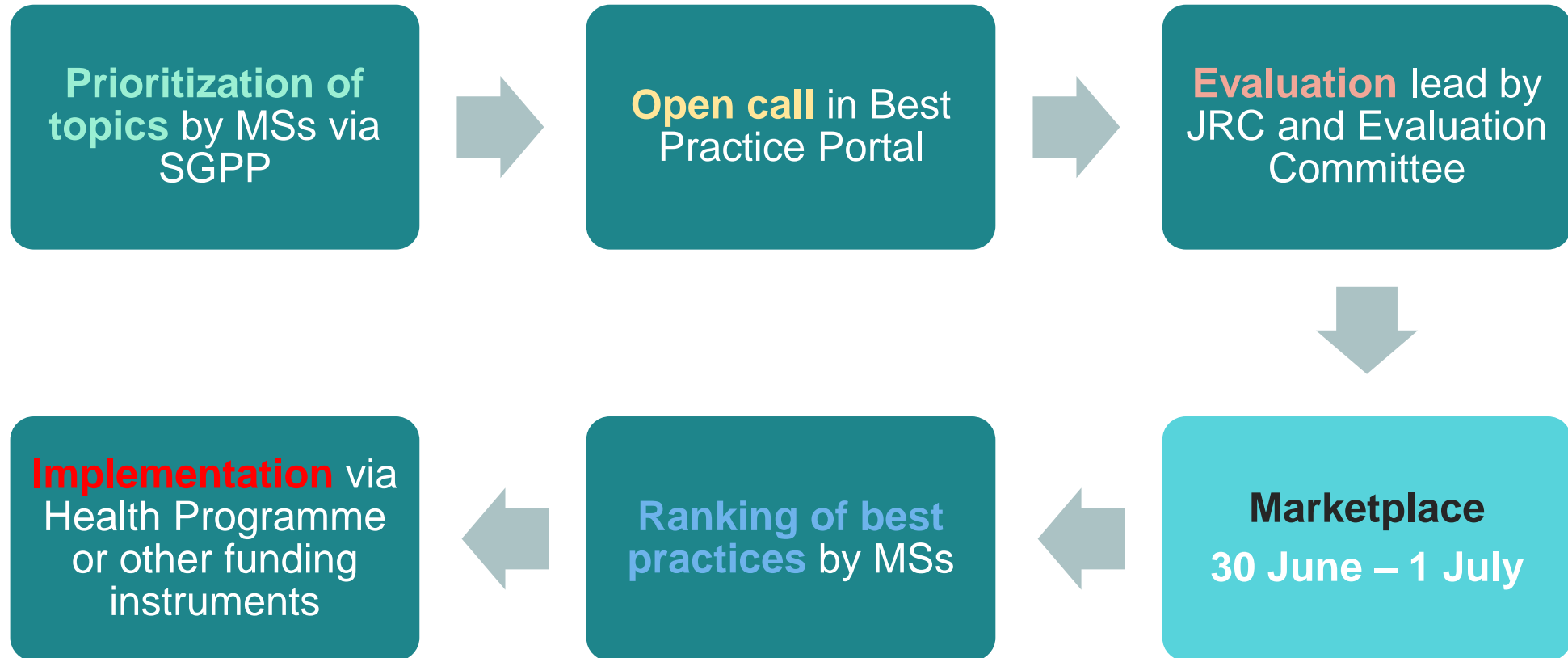

SGPP meeting 18 June

Best practice submissions

- 43 submissions were received in total
- 16 of the submitted practices were evaluated as ‘best practices’ according to 10 criteria
- The topics were varied, not only related to NCDs risk factors
- 10 best practices in the coming **marketplace** address *risk factors of NCDs* (obesity, nutrition, diabetes, alcohol and tobacco consumption) and *mental health*, which were identified by the SGPP as priority topics in 2020 and 2021
